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

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

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
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Style "A" (single door installation shown) with Half-Frosted Glass:

NOTE: This model features the Half-Frosted glass option.

The textured surface on the door glass should be installed to face outside of the shower. The door glass can be flipped for left or right-hand installation.

This model is treated with DreamLine's exclusive ClearMax™ Glass technology. This is a specially formulated coating that prevents the build up of soap and water spots.







NOTE: The Unidoor series doors and enclosures are reversible for left or right-hand installation. This manual will show the right-hand installation. For a left-hand installation, simply begin on the opposite wall and reverse the orientation of the parts as necessary.


Preparation

- 1. Prior to installation, examine all boxes and packages for shipping damage and compare the piece count with your packing slip. After opening all boxes and packages read this introduction carefully. Check that all of the necessary parts are included in the package(s) by checking off the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Shower Door Components". If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or is missing parts, please contact our customer support department within 3 business days of the delivery date. Please note that DreamLine® will not replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 3 business days or if the product has been installed. Please contact DreamLine® if you have any questions and please provide an order number, job name or other proof of purchase to help identify the original order.
- 2. Please note that you should consult your local building codes with questions about installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine® is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.
- 3. If this unit is going to be installed in a new construction, install all of the required plumbing and drainage before installing the shower. **Use a competent and licensed (if required by local code)** plumber for all plumbing installation.
- 4. Make sure that prior to beginning the installation, the surfaces are leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right angles. Irregular installation surface level, radius corners or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Please note that some adjustments and drilling will be necessary during the installation process.
- 5. Protect all primary surfaces of the product during installation. Never set glass down directly onto a hard surface unless instructed. Leave corner protectors in place until necessary to remove them. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard to protect the bottom edge and corners of the glass prior to and during installation to prevent damage.
- 6. This unit must be installed upon a level finished threshold and against plumb finished walls.
- 7. This door is extremely heavy and the hinges on this door must be attached into studs or to preinstalled 2" × 6" wood reinforcement behind the wall. See pages 9, 10 & 11 for details.
- 8. The **single** Unidoor installation does NOT have any adjustment for out-of-plumb or out-of-level conditions. Please verify that the walls are plumb and the threshold is level before proceeding with the installation.
- 9. **Professional installation is recommended** for this heavy glass frameless shower door.




NOTE: DO NOT attach the handle to the door glass until instructed.

DO NOT use the handle to lift the glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious injury. Always use an assistant and/or a professional grade glass suction cup when handling heavy glass panels.










NOTE: Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay out and identify all parts using the detailed diagram and packing list in this manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that may have fallen to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine® for replacement.

NOTE: Retain these installation instructions for future reference.

Single Shower Door Assembly and Installation

<u>NOTE</u>: The following shower door installation instructions should be used as a general guide and prerequisite to the installation of the UNIDOOR, UNIDOOR-LS, UNIDOOR LUX and UNIDOOR PLUS models. Before you begin the installation, please check your finished opening size. Specific size information can be found on <u>DreamLine.com</u>



ATTENTION:

This door is extremely heavy and the hinges on this door must be installed into studs or to preinstalled 2×6 wood reinforcement behind the wall.

NOTE: DO NOT attach the handle to the door glass until instructed.

DO NOT use the handle to lift the glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious injury. Always use an assistant or a professional grade glass suction cup when handling the door glass.

1. Attach the **Hinges (05)** to the **Door Glass (01).** Use one hinge gasket per side. Attach the hinges centered in the notches and square with the edge of the door glass. Fully tighten the hinge bolts. **(Fig 1)**

TIP: Clean the hinge gaskets and the glass around the hinge notch with an ammonia free glass cleaner prior to attaching the hinges to the glass.

Never set the glass down directly onto a tile or concrete

floor. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard and leave the corner pads and protective shims on the glass until it becomes necessary to remove them. This will protect the bottom edge and corners from damage which could lead to breakage.



ATTENTION:

For Styles E, I, J & L that have return panels:

Please check the model dimensions for proper placement of the Door Glass (01) so that the door glass will align correctly with the return panel glass.


2. The **Door Glass (01)** ships with four 5/8" shims attached to the top (2pcs) and bottom (2pcs). Determine the swing of your door and only remove the shims from the top of the door glass, leaving the bottom shims in place. Set the **Door Glass (01)** onto the threshold at the desired location and check for level. These 5/8" shims will leave the proper spacing at the bottom of the door glass and will ensure that the door height finishes at 72", but always confirm with a measurement. Carefully butt the door with the hinged side against the wall, adjust its position and check for plumb with a level. (Fig 2)

ATTENTION:

Check the door glass with a level to verify that it is plumb before marking the hinge positions.

TIP:

When installing the door along with panel glass, use the 72" Anti-Water strip (Inline) (19) that is packed with the panel glass as a height reference to be sure that the door height will match the panel glass at 72".




3. Hold the door in place and mark the drill holes for both **Hinges (05)** on the wall. Set the door aside and use a Ø 1/4" drill bit to drill holes up to the stud. Drill 1/8" pilot holes into the stud if necessary.

IMPORTANT:

The included PVC hinge spacers (31) are provided to compensate for minor outof-plumb wall conditions. Use only as necessary as their use could compromise the opening size of your shower. Please see Fig 4 for an installation example*.

4. Place the **Door Glass (01)** back onto the threshold along with the 5/8" spacers and attach both hinges to the wall with two Countersunk screws ST5×70 (04) on the hinge from outside of the shower. Then open the door and install the remaining screws to both wall plates from the inside.

(Fig 3 and Fig 4)



TIP: The PVC hinge spacer can also be used as a template to assist with marking the hinge mounting holes.

*Only use the PVC hinge spacer to correct for minor out-of-plumb wall conditions.



ATTENTION:

As viewed from inside the shower, the hinge plate is very close to the drilled holes in the wall and might get scratched while installing the long screws. Be careful not to scratch the hinge surfaces during installation.

(OPTIONAL)

5. Carefully remove the hinge plates from the **Hinges (05)** (Fig 5.1), remove the **Door Glass (01)** and carefully set it aside.

Install the remaining Countersunk screws ST5 x 70 (04) into the wall, place the Door Glass (01) (with the 5/8" bottom spacers still attached) back into position onto the Hinges (05) and re-assemble the Hinges (05). Once the door glass is secure, remove the 5/8" spacers from beneath the Door Glass (01). (Fig 5)




Setting the Adjustable Hinges

The Adjustable hinges are pre-set to overclose to 85° and are adjustable up to 90° after the door is installed. Once the door glass is installed, simply loosen the Allen set screws and position the door to the desired closed position. While holding the door in the new closed position, retighten the Allen screws and your door will now self-center to the chosen closed position.



5a. Make sure the door glass is plumb and the edge of the hinge is installed flush with the glass edge. Center the hinge in the glass notch and tighten the faceplate screws **(Fig 5a)**. Be careful not to scratch the finished surfaces of the hinge during installation.





5b. The hinges are factory set to 85 degrees.

You can change this angle by using the adjustment screws on the hinge plate.

(Fig 5b)



5c. Use the supplied Allen Key to loosen the adjustment screws on the inside hinge plate, adjust the door to the desired angle (90 degrees for example) then retighten the adjustment screws **(Fig 5c).** Be sure that you create a tight seal with the supplied strike vinyl when the door is in the closed position.



6. Mount the Handle (02) to the Door Glass (01). (Fig 6)



7. Measure the bottom of the **Door Glass** (01) from end to end to determine the actual width of the **door**. Cut the **Bottom anti-water strip** (07) to the size of your measurement and notch approximately 3/8" off the inner side of the **Bottom anti-water strip as shown**. Press the **Bottom Anti-water strip** (07) tightly onto the bottom edge of the **Door Glass** (01).

NOTICE:

Make sure the **Bottom anti-water strip** is flush to the vertical edge of the **Handle** side of the **Door Glass**. (Fig 7)






- 8. Take three measurements:
 - from the top edge of the **Door Glass (01)** to the upper body of the top **Hinge (05)** (+) 7/8"
 - from the lower body of the upper **Hinge** to the upper body of the bottom **Hinge** (+) 1-3/4"
 - from the lower body of the bottom Hinge to top of the installed Bottom anti-water strip (07) (+) 1-7/8"

Cut the **Side strip (06)** according to the measurements.

Notch the cut strips to be able to slide them into the **Hinge** and around the sweep vinyl to cover the space to the wall.

Press the cut strips onto the vertical edge of the **Door Glass**. (Fig 8)



<u>ATTENTION</u>; Prior to the next step, please be sure that the section of the wall where you need to attach the L-shaped strip (08) is clean, dry and free from soap, oil and any construction debris.

9. Hold the door in the closed position, parallel to the threshold. Place the *L-shaped strip (08) onto the door edge. Make sure that the door glass makes good contact with the entire length of the L-shaped strip (08), and mark its location on the wall. Open the door. Remove the tape backing from the adhesive strip and firmly press the L-shaped strip (08) to the wall. Allow 24 hours for the adhesive to fully setup before use. (Fig 9 and Fig 10)

*NOTE:

The above procedure for installing the L-shaped strip (08) is for the Unidoor Style A single shower door installation only. When installing another model with additional panel glass, please refer to the separate panel installation manual located in the glass packaging for model specific instructions. The vinyl seals that apply to the panel glass are packaged with the panel glass.



If the model includes additional panel glass, refer to the manual that is packaged with the panel glass to continue with the installation.

Product Maintenance

BASES and BACKWALLS: To ensure long-lasting life for your acrylic back walls: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could scratch or dull the surface.

GLASS: To ensure long-lasting life for your glass shower products: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface.

HARDWARE: To ensure a long-lasting finish: wipe off the metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft cloth. Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with (not across) the grain. Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.

<u>NOTE:</u> To maximize the life of your door, it is important to regularly inspect the glass and other hardware for misalignment, proper attachment, and/or damage. Contact DreamLine[®] with any questions or concerns.

DreamLine[®] shower doors and enclosures are designed not to leak when installed properly and the flow of water is not pointed directly at the wall-mounted hinges or vinyl seals.





TEMPERED GLASS WARNING

- Your Shower Door Glass Could Shatter Without Warning if Improperly Installed or Mishandled
- Do Not install or operate a shower door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered edges or
 is otherwise damaged and/or has been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as
 tile marble or glass
- The main causes of tempered glass breakage are:
- o Improper handling, storage or installation
- o Misuse/abuse
- Lack of maintenance
- o Failure to replace damaged glass
- Improper handling during storage, unpacking and installation:
- Corners and edges are the most susceptible area to damage on a lite of tempered glass and should be protected and handled with care during storage, unpacking, installation and operation. A concentrated point of pressure or impact with a surface harder than itself may cause the tempered glass to shatter. The tempered glass may release immediately, within several hours or even days later.
- Incorrect installation of door hardware, rollers, hinges, channels, stopper or glass:
- Improper installation may include: loose hardware and/or lack of proper gaskets between the hardware and glass. Additionally, improper alignment of guide rails, wall profiles or other hardware during installation or operation may place stress on the glass edges and cause it to break.
- This product must be installed by a professional and experienced installer familiar with the safe handling of tempered glass.
- Improper use of this product:
 - Aggressively opening or closing the door may cause trauma to the glass, which can lead to breakage. This may occur immediately or hours or even days later.
 - The shower door hardware and glass should be inspected periodically:
 - Instruct the homeowner how to perform a periodic inspection of the shower hardware and glass - some minor adjustments may be necessary based upon the use (or misuse) of the shower door. Ensure that the hardware remains tight and that the door alignment and operation are correct. Any adjustments should be made upon discovery to prevent damage to the product.
 - Additional considerations should be given to the installation of frameless tempered glass products in households with young children or an elderly person due to an increased chance of improper handling. In such cases, alternatives such as shower curtains or grab bars should be considered.

WARNING: TO AVOID THE RISK OF DAMAGE OR INJURY:

- Follow all recommendations and requirements as shown in the installation instructions.
- Perform a thorough inspection of the glass and all parts for any damage prior to installation. Any damage to tempered glass can cause breakage.

Do Not install damaged glass!

- Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered
 edges or is otherwise damaged. Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door that has
 been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as tile, marble or glass.
- CAUTION: Contact with any hard surface can damage tempered glass and cause it to shatter.
- This product uses tempered glass. Glass cannot be cut after it has been tempered.
 Do Not attempt to cut tempered glass.
- DreamLine® Glass Shower doors, Tub doors, Inline panels, and Return panels can shatter
 due to improper handling or lack of maintenance. Conduct periodic inspections of glass
 and all parts for possible damage, missing or loose parts.
- Always wear proper safety equipment such as: safety goggles, work gloves and appropriate footwear during the installation process.
- WARNING. Risk of leakage and/or damage. Follow all instructions regarding the
 application of silicone sealant or caulk. Allow 24 hours for the sealant to cure before the
 initial use of the shower or tub product. Follow the silicone manufacturer's
 recommendations regarding the use of their product.
- Thoroughly read these instructions before installing or using this product.
- Leave this manual for the end-user of the product.







This door recommends professional installation. Two installers recommended.



This Inline Panel is reversible for right or left inline panel installation. The right-hand inline panel installation is shown as an example throughout this manual. For the left-hand inline panel installation, simply begin on the opposite wall and reverse the orientation of the installation steps shown.



Tools





Measure the finished opening before proceeding with the installation to be sure that the correct model size has been ordered.

Use a good quality waterproof, mildew-resistant 100% silicone.


Cover the shower drain with tape prior to installation to prevent the loss of screws or small parts.

To prevent stripping the screw heads, set power drill to a low setting when installing screws.





Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay it out and identify all parts using the **Detailed Diagram** on page 5; and parts list in this manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that may have fallen to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine® for replacement. The shipping boxes may contain extra parts not used in your model configuration. Retain these installation instructions for future reference.



To assist with aligning the **Inline Panel Glass (#11)** with the pre-installed Door Glass, hold the door glass parallel with the outside of the threshold and mark a reference line on the threshold.





Product Maintenance

BASES and BACKWALLS: To ensure long lasting life for your acrylic back walls: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could permanently scratch or dull the surface.

<u>GLASS</u>: To ensure long lasting life for your glass shower products: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface of the glass.

HARDWARE: To ensure a long lasting finish: wipe off all metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft clean-cloth.


Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with the grain (not across the grain). Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.



To maximize the life of your door, it is important to regularly inspect the glass and other hardware for misalignment, proper attachment, and/or damage. Contact DreamLine® with any questions or concerns.

INLINE PANEL (Style F) Maintenance Checklist

□ Inspect the U-Channels. Make sure both Bottom and Vertical U-Channels are tightly secured.
☐ Inspect that the Door Glass and Inline Panel glass are properly aligned when the door is in the closed position.
□ Inspect the L-Bar™ (for ELEGANCE PLUS models only). Tighten set-screws if necessary.
☐ Inspect and replace damaged or missing Vinyl Seals. Order replacement as necessary to prevent leakage.
☐ Inspect silicone application. Remove and replace as necessary to prevent leakage. (refer to the silicone manufacturer's recommendations on the proper application of their product).
□ Remove Vinyl Seals to inspect the edges of the glass for concealed damage. Damaged glass must be replaced!






