FIXTURE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Read and review installation instruction sheet before assembling the fixture.


- By measuring determine correct number of rods
 needed for proper hanging height. There are 3 optional
 rods included. To shorten the fixture slide the excess
 rods off the wire. To lengthen the fixture thread the
 additional rods onto the wire.
- 2. Pull the fixture's wire through the Rods (G).
- 3. Thread Rod/rods (G) into Fixture frame (H) using the nipples until tight, repeat for the additional rods. Thread the Swivel assembly (F) to the Rod (G).

NOTE: INSTALL THE GLASS ASSEMBLY AFTER THE FIXTURE IS HUNG.

- Place the Glass Shades (J) over the Threaded
 Sockets(I) and secure by threading the Socket Ring (K)
 to Threaded Socket (I) until tight..
- 5. Install the light bulbs in accordance with the fixture's specifications.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

For Mini pendant Fixture

WARNING! SHUT OFF POWER AT FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER.

HANGING THE FIXTURE as Semi flush (Fig. 1)

- 1. Carefully remove the new fixture from the carton and the yellow bag that holds all your parts. Check that all parts are included as shown in the illustration and parts list.
- 2. Shut off power at the circuit breaker and remove the old fixture from ceiling, including the old mounting strap.
- 3. The Circular Mounting Strap (A) contains several pairs of threaded holes, find the pair of holes that match the hole spacing in your fixture Back Plate (D) and thread the two Mounting Screws (C) half way into the Mounting Strap (A) facing down, Secure in place with hex nuts. These will have their threaded ends protrude through the two holes in the fixture canopy (D).
- 4. Place the Mounting Strap (A) over the junction box.
- 5. Attach the Mounting Strap (A) to the Junction Box using the two mounting screws (B). Tighten the screws (B) securely with screw driver.

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig 2)

- 6. Attach the power supply wires to the fixture lead wires by connecting BLACK to BLACK (or SMOOTH) and WHITE to WHITE (or RIBBED).
- 7. Attach the GROUND wire(GREEN or COPPER) from the Junction Box and the fixture Ground wire to the green Ground Screw on the Mounting Bracket (A) or connect both wires together using the correct size of wire connectors.

NOTE:Twist the wires together in the same direction you twist the wire connector onto the wires.

8. Tuck these wire connections neatly into the Junction Box.

FINISHING THE INSALLATION (Fig.3)

- 9. Place the fixture's canopy over the Mounting Strap (A) and over the Mounting Screws (C), adjust the fixture canopy (D) until the Mounting Screws (C) protrude out from the canopy (D) and secure the fixture against the ceiling by threading the decorative nuts (E) until tight.
- 10. Install the light bulbs and glass shade as per the fixture assembly sheet.

YOUR INSTALLATION IS NOW COMPLETE. RETURN POWER TO THE JUNCTION BOX AND TEST THE FIXTURE.
