Installation Instructions

For Portable Lamp

WARNING

- Risk of shock, do not plug in the unit before assembly.
- Do not exceed the maximum wattage rating. Ne pas depasser la puissance nominale maximale.
- Before you begin assembly of your new fixture, please follow the instruction manual step by step.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Place all parts on a smooth, flat surface to protect the finish until ready to install.
- 2. Place Glass shields (E) across Cluster (G), then install Studs and secure tightly using Knurled knobs (D).
- 3. Install Pipe (C) by unscrewing the screw (P), then tighten the Pipe (C) With Screw (P).
- 4. Install the Bulb (F) into socket. Please use E26 medium base 100W MAX plus 1pc GU10 35W bulbs.
- 5. Place the Shade (B) into the center Pipe (C), then place plastic Washer (O) and Glass Shield (N) to the top of shade (B) and tighten with Finial (A).
- 6. The lamp fixture has two Switches (H) that operate the Bulb (F) and the Bulb (J) separately.
- 7. If you need change Bulb (J)
 - a. Loosen Screws (M) in turn and remove Bulb cover (L).
 - b. Loosen Screws (I) in turn, and then remove Metal ring (K).
 - c. Change and install the new bulb, then install Screws (M), (I), Bulb cover (L) and Metal ring (K) in place according to above-mentioned steps. Your installation is now complete. Make sure all portion of the lamp are secured tightly.
- 8. This fixture has Handle (Q) control system that adjusts the Bulb (J) position.



Lighted lamp is HOT!


WARNING: In handling of halogen bulb, care should be taken not to touch it with your bare hands. Oil residue will shorten the life of the halogen bulb. If you accidentally come in contact, wipe thoroughly with a clean, lint-free, cotton cloth. Allow the bulb to cool for 10 minutes before changing the bulb.

- Turn off/unplug and allow cooling before replacing bulb (lamp)
- Bulb (lamp) gets HOT quickly! Only contact switch/plug when turning on
- 3. Do not touch hot lens, guard, or enclosure.
- 4. Do not remain in light if skin feels warm.
- 5. Do not look directly at lighted lamp.
- 6. Keep lamp away from materials that may burn.
- 7. Do not touch the bulb (lamp) at any time. Use a soft cloth. Oil from skin may damage bulb(lamp)
- 8. Do not operate the portable luminaries with a missing or damaged guard, lamp containment barrier, or UV filter.

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.
