



Recommended Installation by Professional Plumbing Contractor

Note: The use of petroleum base plumbers' putty on our products will nullify the warranty. We recommend the use of clear silicone sealing materials.

Valve Trim Installation

Note: Perform these steps after finished wall has been completed.





For Type I or 2 handles:

- 1. Assemble the HANDLE HUB (not shown) or ESCUTCHEON (8) and BONNET (9) onto NIPPLE (1) until they bottom out against the cover PLATE (5).
- 2. Mark the excess exposed NIPPLE (I) length. Remove the ESCUTCHEON (8) and BONNET (9) to trim the excess NIPPLE (I) length.
- 3. Re-install the ESCUTCHEON (8) and BONNET (9) onto the trimmed NIPPLE (1).
- 4. Temporarily place HANDLE (10) onto STEM (3), measure DISTANCE A between the bottom of HANDLE (10) and top surface of BONNET (9). For Type 1 handle, trim STEM (3) by DISTANCE A + 1/16" (Ex: If DISTANCE A is 1", the trimmed amount will be 1-1/16"). For Type 2 handle, trim STEM (3) by DISTANCE A + 3/8".

For Type 3 handle:


- 1. Screw the handle assembly onto NIPPLE (I) until it stops. Measure DISTANCE B between the bottom of the handle assembly to the cover PLATED (5).
- 2. Trim NIPPLE (I) by DISTANCE B. Trim STEM (3) in the way it is 3/4" longer than the top surface of the trimmed NIPPLE (I). Re-install the handle assembly.





Tub Spout Installation (for BP trim with tub spout only):

- I. Place base RING (2) onto bottom of SPOUT (I).
- 2. Base on finished wall thickness, select appropriate size ½" NPT NIPPLE (3) for SPOUT (1) installation. **Note:** NIPPLE (3) is not included.
- 3. Apply thread sealant to both ends of NIPPLE (3) and thread SPOUT (1) to NIPPLE (3).
- 4. Use SPOUT (I) as leverage to thread NIPPLE (3) into fitting inside finish wall.
- 5. As applicable, use a needle nose plier to temporarily remove stream STRAIGHTENER (4) from SPOUT (1).



Testing:

- 1. Turn on the shower valve by rotating the handle counterclockwise. Check for leak.
- 2. For BP trim with diverter, pull the diverter knob to operate the showerhead. Check for leak.
- 3. Hanlde rotation to water mixing temperature is as follows:
 - a. 0 to 45° = cold
 - b. 45° to 90° = warm
 - c. 90° to 150° = hot
