



To Whom It May Concern:

This is to certify that Shurtape® AF 914 Pressure Sensitive Tape is outside the scope of the requirements set forth by the European Union Directive 2011/65/EU – ROHS II and the European Union Directive 2002/96/EC – WEEE relating to electronics and electrical equipment which bans or limits certain heavy metals and polybrominated flame retardants. However, Shurtape confirms due diligence has been performed through careful review of raw material specifications, vendor certifications, and random testing to insure its product does not contain heavy metals, Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs), or Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDEs) as unintended impurities in concentrations exceeding EU regulatory limits.

AF 914 meets the European Union Directive 94/62/EC in regards to packaging standards, which restrict quantities of Lead, Cadmium, Mercury (Hg) and – compounds, and Hexavalent Chromium (Cr=6).

Raw materials utilized in the production process may contain unintended impurities that include the aforementioned heavy metals. Further, asbestos is not used as a component in any Shurtape product.

Shurtape® hereby certifies that, to the best of its knowledge, this product does not contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity (“Proposition 65 Chemicals”) at levels which would require a warning. Further, AF 914 is compliant with JIG-101 standards and the requirements and guidelines as stated by CONEG (Coalition of Northeastern Governors) Model legislation for restriction of metals in packaging.

AF 914 is an article as defined by Article 3(3) of Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (REACH). As an article, AF 914 is not subject to the Safety Data Sheet requirements outlined in Article 33(1) of the same Regulation. AF 914 does not have an intended release of a chemical substance, is not a chemical mixture, and is not subject to pre-registration or the registration process. AF 914 contains no “substances of very high concern” (SVHC) in a concentration above 0.1% (w/w) as promulgated 28 October 2008 (REACH Article 59) on the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (REACH Annex XIV) inclusive of updates through June 2012. Shurtape® continues to monitor the SVHC list and its updates.
