

## What You Need To Know:

## Important Notes:

Be sure to read instructions thoroughly before
beginning installation. Do not overtighten any connections or damage may occur. This faucet has an operating range of $20-80 \mathrm{psi}$.

## Safery Tips:

Cover your drain to prevent loss of parts.
Be sure to wear eye protection while culting pipe

## Maintenance:

Your new Roman Tub Faucet is designed for years of trouble-free performance. Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.

Drill holes in finished deck per diagram.
This system is intended for installations up to $2^{\prime \prime}$ thick.

From underneath the deck, insert valve body with
rubber washer (1), metal washer (2), and mounting rubber washer (1), metal washer (2), and mounting
nut (3), through holes on the right (COLD) side. From above, thread flange (4) onto valve stem. Tighten mounting nut (3), so that the flange (4) sits flush to the surface of working area. Repeat for left (HOT) side. Note: HOT side end valve is labeled.
(3) Thread Handle Assembly (1) onto Flange (2)

(4) Place spout assembly (1)thru mounting hole in deck Secure spout with rubber washer (2), metal washer (3), and nut (4). Tighten nut (4) securely with wrench.

& \text { completely seated. Place clip (3) thru slots (4). }
