



## Installing Telescope by Using Spring Clips

# Installing Telescope by Using Fixture Connectors







A Remove the piercing screw from the fixture connectors.

5 Adjust the fixture arm position on the Kable Lite cables by loosening the thumb screw on the supplemental connectors.

6 After fixture arm adjustment, retighten the thumb screws.

7 Push the fixture connectors one onto each Kable Lite cable. Replace and tighten the piercing screws into the fixture connectors.

## Halogen Lamp General Information

 A new halogen lamp may smoke slightly when it is used for the first time. This is perfectly normal; the protective coating is simply being vaporized.

## Two Tips For Prolonging Halogen Lamp Life

- First avoid touching the lamp with bare hands during installation. Any contaminant, even the oil from your hands can deteriorate the lamp. Rubbing alcohol can be used to remove any contaminant.
- Second, do not run the lamps at full power when you do not need to. However, if dimming the fixture for an extended period of time, occasionally bring the light up to full brightness for a few minutes to complete the halogen cycle.
