

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

HANGING THE FIXTURE

1. Shut off power at the fuse box or circuit breaker box. Remove old fixture from wall.
2. Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
3. Attach the crossbar (A) to the Outlet Box using all the two Screws (B) from the outlet box. The side of the Crossbar marked "GND" must face out. (Fig.1)
4. Thread the Nipple (C) part way into the center hole of the Crossbar (A). (Fig.1)
5. Install the Glass panel (G) into Fixture Body (E) and secure with the tabs provided.
6. At this point, connect the electrical wires as shown in (Fig.2), making sure that all wire nuts are secured, If your outlet has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture Ground Wire (D) to it. Otherwise connect the fixture Ground Wire (D) directly to the Crossbar (A) using the Green Screw provided. After wires are connected, tuck them carefully inside the outlet box as you hold the Fixture (E) toward the wall.
7. Finish mounting the Fixture by aligning it over the Nipple (C) so it goes through the hole in the Back plate of the Fixture (E). Tighten with Knurled Cap Nut (F) onto the Nipple (C) to lock the Fixture against the wall. (Fig.1)
8. To prevent moisture from entering the outlet box and causing a short, use clear caulking (i.e. indoor/outdoor Silicone Sealant) to outline the outside of fixture back-plate where it meets the wall leaving a space at bottom to allow moisture a means to escape (Fig.3).

9. Install the proper light bulbs according to the fixture specifications. **(DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING!) (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!)**

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.

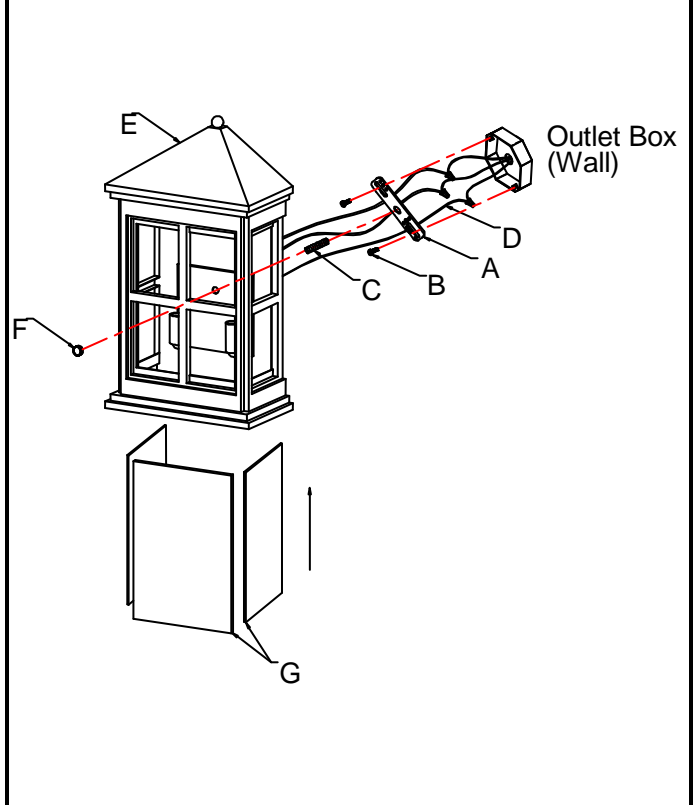

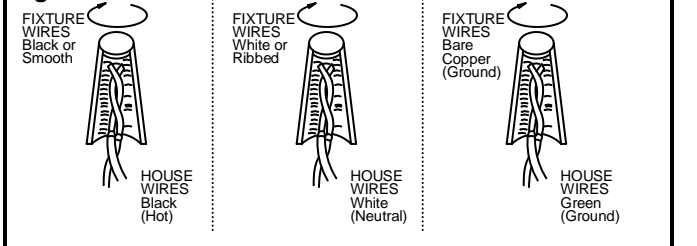
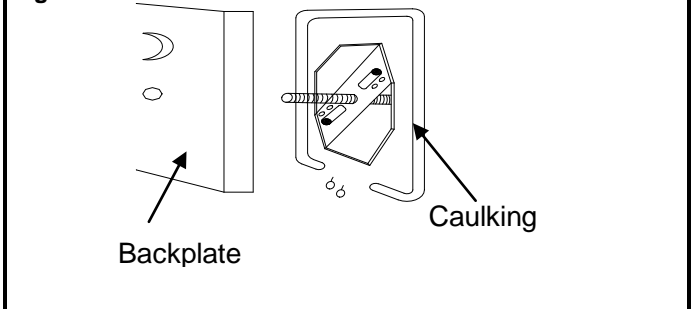
