


## **Drawing 1 - Fixture Mounting**




Drawing 2 - Glass Replacement



## assembly instructions

**1.** Find a clear area in which you can work.

2. Unpack fixture and glass from carton.

3. Carefully review instructions prior to assembly.

\*\*\* The construction of this fixture will be accomplished by first installing the glass, making all necessary electrical connections, and then mounting the fixture to the pole.

SAFETY WARNING: READ WIRING AND GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS (I.S. 18) AND ANY ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS. TURN POWER SUPPLY OFF DURING INSTALLATION. IF NEW WIRING IS REQUIRED, CONSULT A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN OR LOCAL AUTHORITIES FOR CODE REQUIREMENTS.

- Make electrical connections from supply wire to fixture lead wires. Refer to instruction sheet **(I.S. 18)** and follow all instructions to make all necessary wiring connections. Then refer back to this sheet to continue installation of this fixture.
  - **1.** One upright **(1)** is removable to facilitate installation or replacement of the glass and lamping of the fixture **see Drawing 3**.
  - 2. Remove screws (3) from top of fixture and pull upright (1) off fixture.
  - 3. Fixture can now be lamped accordingly.

4. Tilt glass (2) and slip up into top of fixture, lift glass (2) over center hub (4) and set on uprights (1).

**5.** Slide upright **(1)** back onto the fixture, over the brackets **(5)**, lining up holes in upright **(1)** with holes in brackets **(5)**.

6. Thread top screw (3) into top of bracket (5).

7. Lift glass (2) up and using a short screw driver, thread screw (3) into bracket (5) to secure lower portion of upright.

1. After wiring connections are complete, slip post fitter (A) over top of pre-installed post (B) making sure all wire connections are tucked inside the pole - see Drawing 1.

**2.** When fixture is slipped over pole make sure no wires are being pinched between the top edge of the pole and the inside of the post fitter.

- 3. Thread the 3 set screws (C) into pre-tapped holes in post fitter.
- 4. Tighten screw (C) to secure fixture to post.

Note: Maximum wattage for 1321 fixture is 100 watts per bulb.
