ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER AT THE MAIN FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements.

- 1. Thread two screws through the mounting strap, then secure them with two lock nuts. Adjust the length of the screws if necessary.
- 2. Attach the mounting strap to the ceiling box by using two mounting screws.
- 3. Rod connections:
 - a. Thread the fixture wire from the fixture through the down rod and secure the down rod with the nipple.
 - b. Thread the fixture wire from the down rod through the middle rod and secure the middle rod with the nipple.
 - c. Thread the fixture wire through the upper rod and secure the upper rod with the nipple.

The height can be adjusted to 15-3/4", 25-1/4", 34-3/4" or 44-3/4" by using the rods.

- 4. Thread the fixture wire through the canopy and secure the upper rod to the canopy with the set nipple.
- 5. Pull out the outlet wires and the house grounding wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire nuts:
 - ---The black wire from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ---The white wire from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting strap with the green grounding screw. Then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.

Carefully tuck the wires back into the ceiling box.

- 6. Attach the canopy to the mounting strap by inserting the screws through the holes of the canopy and secureing them with two bolt nuts.
- 7. Attach the glass shade to the glass holder, then secure it with the socket ring.
- 8. Install a bulb (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 9. Turn on the main power at fuse or circuit breaker box.
