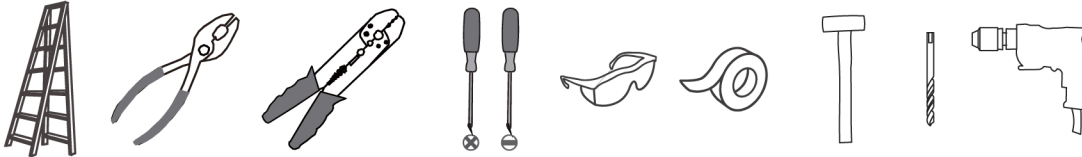

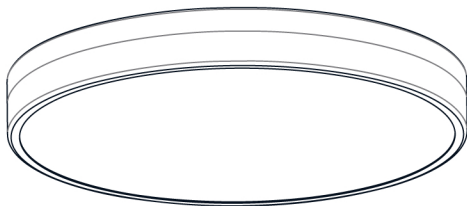

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

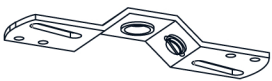
- Wipe clean using soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid using harsh chemicals and abrasives to clean fixture as they may damage the finish.

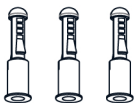

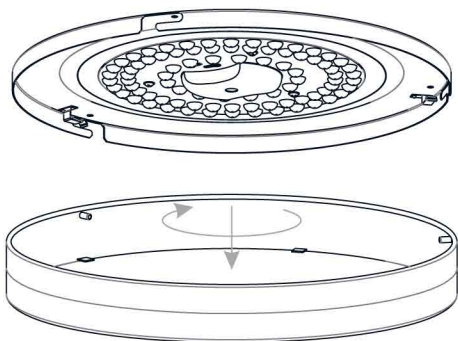

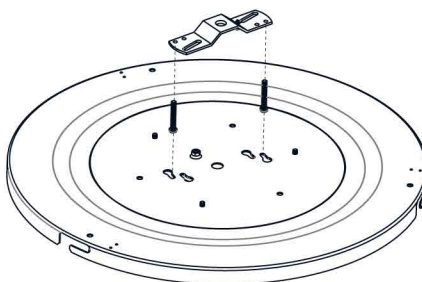

1 Remove Shade From Fixture Body

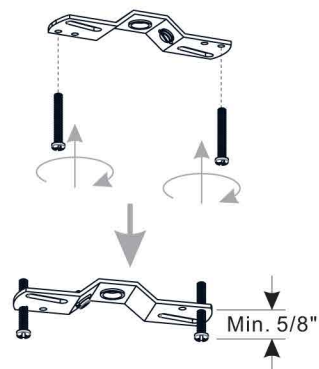


2 Install Mounting Screws to Crossbar

Determine mounting holes for mounting screws

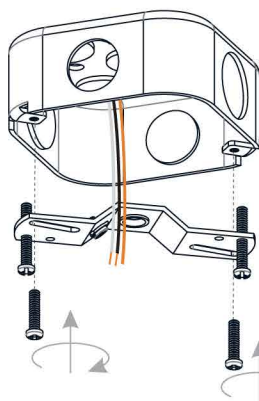


Install mounting screws



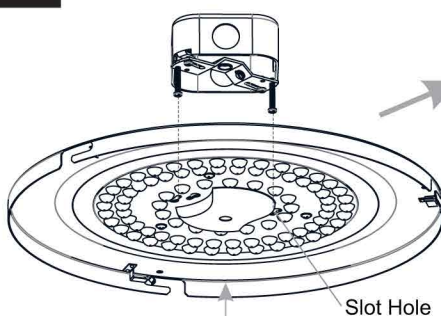
* **DO NOT** screw mounting screws all in the crossbar. Leave a minimum length of 5/8" for next installations.

3 Install Crossbar

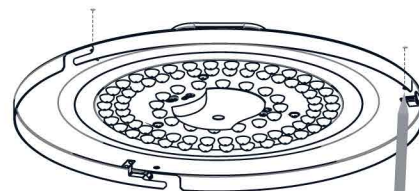


Outlet Box

4 Install Wall Anchors



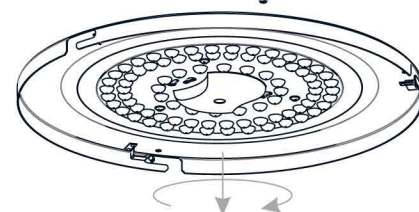
Fit slot holes to mounting screws, rotate the fixture body until it is hung on mounting screws safely.

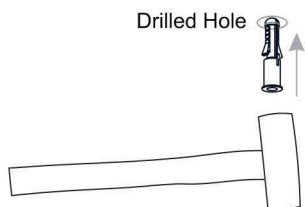

1/4" Drill Bit

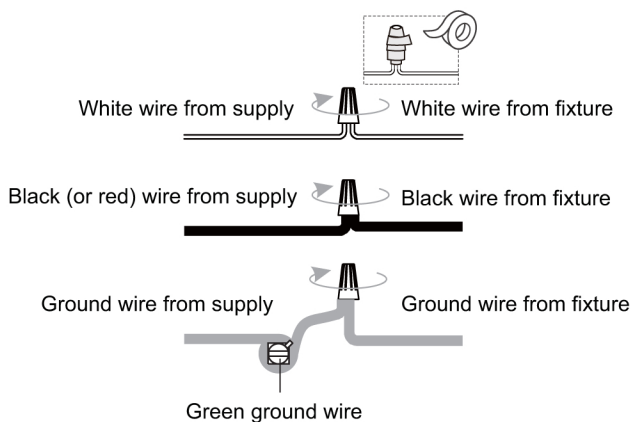
Drill holes for wall anchors from marks

Drilled Hole

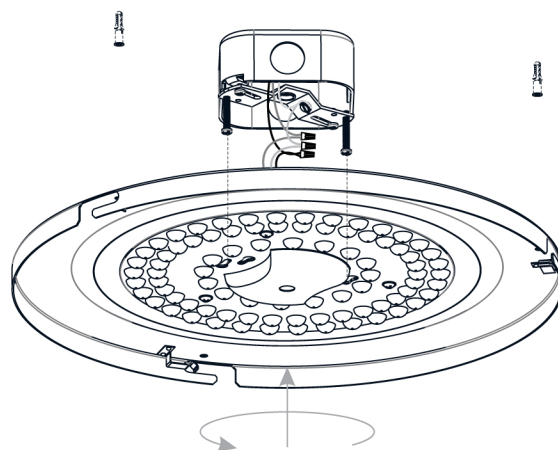


Install wall anchors into drilled holes

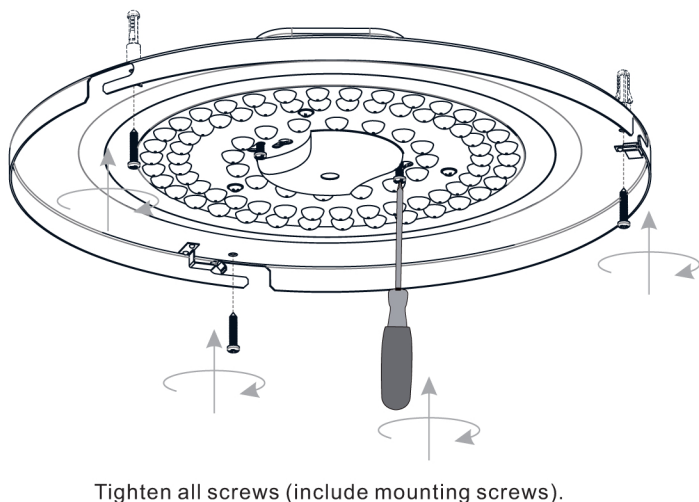

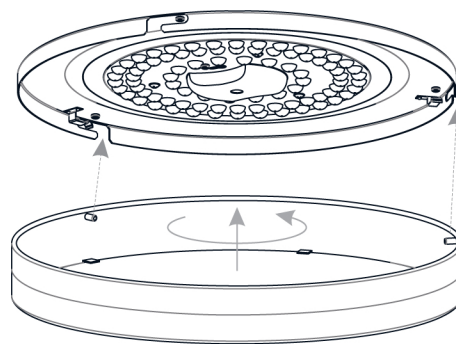
6 Hang Fixture Body to Mounting Screws
