#### FOR 2300W / 3400W MODELS

#### THESE REQUIREMENTS MUST BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PLATINUM SMART-HEAT<sup>™</sup> ELECTRIC HEATER SERIES II INSTALLATION, INSTRUCTION AND SERVICE MANUAL

These accompanying requirements provide additional detail to the designer/installer as to the limitations of cavity design and required clearance spaces for the Platinum Electric Heaters. The designer/installer can select **either** OPTION 1 or OPTION 2.

These instructions **DO NOT** reduce the required cavity space – but seek to clarify as to how to mount the heaters and support the ceiling structure whilst also complying with the requirements.

In summary, open space is required in the combustion free zone – with the exclusion of structural members as indicated - to ensure the heater and surrounds stay below safe operating temperatures. Surrounding materials at the edge of the COMBSTIBLE FREE ZONE MUST BE RATED FOR OPERATION AT 149 °F above ambient temperature. The construction of a heater box is not required.

#### Summary of Details:

- First row of structural members, immediate to heater **MUST** be protected by a minimum of 1 x layer of 5/8" fire board rated for 149 °F above ambient temperature boards to be butt jointed as indicated.
- Minimum 4" gap between fire protected structural members and ceiling is required.
- Maximum section size of structural members (timbers/joists/battens) is 2" x 6".
- The recess kits must be supported along the short side of the kit fixing along the long side is optional.
- A gap will be present between the recess kit and the fire boards appropriate spacers should be installed to prevent recess kit deformation.
- Minimum centre to centre spacing of joists 16" as depicted in diagrams.

MARNING A: This heater MUST be permanently installed by an authorised/licenced person. Do not perform maintenance or carry out installation or assembly procedure while electrical power is switched on. Wait 2 hours after switching off the heater before handling.

- Recommended Fire Protection is required ONLY for recess positions utilising Timber.
- All clearances defined within the complete INSTALLATION, INSTRUCTION AND SERVICE MANUAL MUST be met.
- The Instructions within are suitable for ceiling surfaces 10-30mm thick. For ceiling surfaces thicker than 30mm, contact Bromic for alternative installation options.
