Roman Tub Installation Instructions

CALIFORNIA FAUCETS RECOMMENDS THAT ALL PLUMBING PRODUCTS BE INSTALLED BY A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL

IMPORTANT: Read all instructions prior to installation and provide copy of instructions to consumer. Operating Specifications:

Recommended Supply Pressure: 20 to 70 psi [1.4 to 4.8 bar]*†


- * Operating pressures between hot and cold supplies should vary no more than 30 psi [2.1 bar].
- † If water pressure exceeds 70 psi [4.8 bar], install a Pressure-Reducing Valve (PRV).

INSTALLING SPOUT

- Remove BRASS NUT (2), WASHER (3), CUP SPACER
 (4), and SHANK (5) from SPOUT (1)
- Apply Teflon®tape (6) to threaded portion of SPOUT (1)
- Insert spout SHANK (5) through hole in deck

NOTE: Sink / Deck recommended hole size is Ø1-3/8" [35mm]

Place CUP SPACER (4), WASHER (3), and BRASS NUT
 (2) onto spout SHANK (5) from below and secure to tub/deck



2 INSTALLING VALVES

• From underneath insert VALVE (7) though appropriate tub/deck hole

IMPORTANT: VALVES (7) are labeled as follows:


BLUE is COLD left turning (counterclockwise) closed

RED is HOT right-turning (clockwise) closed

Position flange NUT (8), WASHER (9), and CUP SPACER (10) (if necessary) so that VALVE (7) extends above tub/deck surface according to table

- Secure VALVE (7) with INVERTED NUT (11)
- Place handle RING (12) onto valve THREADS (7a) and secure to sink/deck surface



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INSTALLING HANDLES

- Place handle SPACER (13) onto valve THREADS (7a)
- Slide handle CARRIER (14) down onto and engage valve STEM (7b)


IMPORTANT: HANDLE (15) will be aligned with carrier FLATS (14b). To obtain proper alignment it may be necessary to rotate VALVE (7) so that HANDLE (15) is aligned to desired orientation.


- Secure CARRIER (14) with SETSCREW (14a)
- Place and press down HANDLE (15) onto CARRIER (14)

IMPORTANT: handle FLATS (I5a) MUST align with carrier FLATS (I4b)

TO REMOVE HANDLE

- Grip HANDLE (15) and pull up
- If HANDLE (15) does not come off, pry between HANDLE (15) and handle RING (12) with thin non-marring object





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INSTALLING SUPPLY LINES

- Must use rigid copper piping (not flex) for all connections between spout and valves
- California Faucets recommends that all installation types have access panel(s) to allow for maintenance and/or service

Disclaimer: To conform to local codes and/or ordinances, it may be required that California Faucets Roman Tub sets be installed in conjunction with an ASSE 1070 approved tempering valve or equivalent (not included) to reduce hot water supply to a safe temperature.

Important: the INSTALLER is responsible to check local codes and/or ordinances, to confirm and verify proper maximum hot water temperature settings for all products installed

Warning: Water temperatures in excess of 110° F (43°C) are dangerous and may cause severe scalding and injury
