

Rainscape™ Showerhead Installation Instructions

CALIFORNIA FAUCETS RECOMMENDS THAT ALL PLUMBING PRODUCTS BE INSTALLED BY A LICENSED PROFESSIONAL



CUT OUT CEILING

NOTE: Following step shall be performed on finished (e.g., paint, tile, etc.) ceiling surface.

- Tape or tack provided **TEMPLATE (2)** to ceiling
- Mark onto the ceiling locations for mounting holes and cutout for **SHOWERHEAD (I)**
- Use appropriate tools (e.g., utility knife, drill, etc.) to carefully drill mounting holes and showerhead cutout

IMPORTANT: Exact mounting hole locations and cutout for **SHOWERHEAD (1)** is critical to ensure proper installation

3 INSTALLING SUPPLY LINE


- Apply 2-3 wraps of Teflon tape to tapered end (long end) of **ADAPTER (3)**
- Tighten ADAPTER (3) onto 1/2" NPT (female) water supply
- Secure STRAIGHT END (4a) of HOSE (4) onto ADAPTER (3)


NOTE: Before attaching showerhead, turn on water supply valve and flush system for 2 minutes

• Secure 90° BENT END (4b) of HOSE (4) showerhead INLET (5)

IMPORTANT: SHOWERHEAD (1) may need to move to different location if there are any obstructions above the shaded area, marked in the template.

• Prior to mounting **SHOWERHEAD (I)** in place, turn on water supply valve and check for leaks at all connects





MOUNT SHOWERHEAD

NOTE: Follow one or both of the following attachment methods based on ceiling construction

<u>Non-supported ceiling</u>: **NO** ceiling/floor joists located behind mounting locations on **SHOWERHEAD (1)**

<u>Supported ceiling:</u> YES ceiling/floor joists located behind mounting locations on SHOWERHEAD (1)

<u>Non-supported</u> ceiling attachment method (use toggle screw(s))

- Remove toggle ANCHOR (9) from SCREW (8)
- Insert SCREW (8) into showerhead MOUNT (1a)
- Attach toggle ANCHOR (9) onto SCREW (8)
- Push toggle **ANCHOR (9)** into drilled hole locations(s)
- Tighten SCREW (8) to secure SHOWERHEAD (1) in place

<u>Supported</u> ceiling attachment method (use wood screw(s))

- Tighten wood SCREW (7) to secure SHOWERHEAD
 (1) in place
- Install decorative CAPS (6) to cover SCREWS (7) or (8)
