Incandescent
 Most common bulb type
 Can be used with dimmer
 Various decorative shapes
 Last average 1,000-2,000 hrs



Halogen
 Energy-saving alternative to incandescent
 Brighter and longer lifetime than incandescent



CFL
 Compact fluorescent lamp
 Energy-efficient
 Longer lifetime than incandescent or halogen



LED
 Light Emitting Diode.
 Produces light up to 90% more efficiently than incandescent light bulbs
 Rated life of up to 50,000 hours

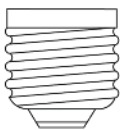
