Thermal expansion or leaking pressure reducing valves may require use of expansion tanks or relief valves to ensure your system never exceeds its maximum intended pressure setting.
- NOTE 2: Control Box #0 and #1 are designed for routine 171°F (77°C) disinfection cycles up to 30 minutes.
- NOTE 3: Control Box #8 is not recommended for high temperature disinfection cycles as the thermostatic mixing valve limits the higher temperature flow output.


