## **Preparation**

- 1. After opening all boxes and packages, read this introduction carefully. Check that all of the needed parts are included in the package by marking all the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Shower Door Components". Examine boxes and packages for shipping damage. If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or is missing parts, please contact our customer support department within 5 business days of the delivery date. Please note that **DreamLine™ will not** replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 5 business days or if the **product has been installed.** Feel free to contact DreamLine<sup>™</sup> if you have any questions.
- 2. Please note that you should consult your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.
- 3. Prior to installation, ensure that the installation surface is leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also, make sure the walls are at right angles. Irregular installation surface level or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Please, note that some adjustments and drilling might be necessary during the installation process.
- 4. This unit has to be installed against a finished floor and walls.
- 5. Please, NOTE! This door does not have out-of-plumb adjustment. Make sure your walls are at right angles.
- 6. This door requires a minimum  $2^{3}/4^{"}$  wide threshold, base or installation space.
- 7. Please note that Step 6 calls for installation of the door to the wall using anchors. However, the manufacturer strongly recommends installing these heavy doors to the studs or to preinstalled 2x6 wood reinforcements behind the wall and attach the Wall brackets to it.

Attention: This door is extremely heavy and requires professional installation. Instructions are given for the shower door installation. Please, follow the same instructions to install the tub door.


**NOTE:** Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay it out and identify all parts using parts diagram and part list in your manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that tend to fall to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine<sup>™</sup> for replacement.

**NOTE:** Retain these installation instructions for future reference.

## **Shower Door Installation**

1. Measure the distance between two finished walls. This distance is marked as **"W".** 

See Fig. 1 for details.





 Your Upper Guide rail (03) has been precut for your Shower model opening width:
 48" or 60" for shower width.

If **W**-width of your wall-to-wall opening is equal to the size of your Shower model, it is unnecessary to cut the **Upper Guide rail** and you can continue to <u>Step 3</u>.

If **W**-width of your wall-to-wall opening is less than the size of your Shower model, you will need to cut the **Upper Guide rail** from the end which is farther from the **Glass brackets (07)** holes.


The length to cut off will be L:

**L**=Subtract **W** from the size of your Shower model.

#### FOR EXAMPLE

If your wall opening **W=47**". Your shower model is **48**". **L=48**"-**47**"=**1**", You have to cut **1**" off from the rail.




3. Install the **Upper guide rail (03)** to the **Stationary glass (02)** with the **Glass brackets (07)** and tighten the set screws.


Slide the **Door stoppers (01)** on each end of the **Upper guide rail** and secure them temporarily.

Slide the **Guide Rail brackets (08)** on each end of the **Upper guide rail** and temporarily secure them as well. Assemble the **Wall Bracket (19)** onto the bottom corner of the **Stationary glass (02)**.

#### NOTE:


Before you start installation of the **Stationary glass** (02), you have to take the **Glass door (05)** into the shower room and lean it against the wall.

4. Place the **Stationary glass (02)** on the preinstalled shower base or threshold and butt it up against the wall.

## (<u>Please note that the Guide rail (03) secured on</u> <u>the Stationary Glass should face inside the</u> <u>shower</u>).

Make sure the **Stationary glass** and the **Guide rail** are leveled and aligned with the shower base or threshold. If a horizontal adjustment is required, adjust it in the **Glass brackets (07)**.




 Outline the position of the Wall bracket (19) and Guide Rail brackets (08) on the wall. Set the Stationary glass (02) aside. Remove the Guide Rail Brackets from the Upper Guide Rail (03) and the Wall bracket from the Stationary glass. Place the Wall bracket and Rail bracket to the outlined positions and mark the holes for drilling.

See fig. 6 for details.



 Drill the holes for the Wall bracket (19) using Ø 5/16 drill bit and insert the Wall anchors (9b). Drill the holes for the Rail brackets (08) using Ø 3/8" drill bit and insert the Wall anchors (9a).

See Fig. 7 for details.






7. Fasten the **Wall bracket (19)** to the wall using the **Round head** screw ST4.2×30 (18).

Mount the male parts of the **Rail brackets** onto both walls using the **Round head screw ST6×45 (10)**.



8. Place the **Guide Block (12)** on the shower base or the threshold and place the **Stationary glass (02)** back in to the designated position so it gets in the groove of the **Guide block**.





9. Fasten both female parts of the **Guide rail brackets (08)** to their male parts on the walls.


Tighten the set screws on the **Guide rail brackets** to secure the **Upper guide rail (03)** between the two walls.

Assemble the **Wall bracket (19)** at the bottom corner of the **Stationary glass (02)** using clear vinyl gasket between the glass and the metal part to avoid the glass damage and tighten the bolt.






10. **Upper guide rail (03)** must be leveled horizontally. Adjust **Guide rail bracket (08)** using hex key on both end if it necessary to level the **Upper guide rail**.

Tighten the screws from top and bottom of the **Guide rail bracket**.




11. Parallel the **Stationary glass (02)** to the shower base or threshold. Measure the distance from the side wall to the far edge of the **Guide block (12)**.


This distance will be "X".

Cut the Anti-splash threshold (15) to the size of  $X-\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Insert one side of the **Anti-splash threshold** fully into the **Guide block** and cover the other side with the **Threshold bracket (16)**.

Parallel the **Anti-splash threshold** to the front edge of the shower base or threshold and mark the drilling hole through the **Threshold bracket**.



12. Drill the holes for the **Guide block** 


**Round head screw ST4.2×25 (17).** Cover the holes with the provided decorative plugs.

See Fig. 14 for details.

13. Attach two Rollers (04) to the Glass door (05).
Suspend the door by hanging the Rollers onto the Upper guide rail (03) and slide the bottom edge of the Glass door into the groove of the Guide block (12).
Adjust the fasteners on both Rollers to ensure that the bottom edge of the Glass door does not touch the bottom of the Guide block.
Then mount two Poller guards (20) on the door to

Then mount two **Roller guards (20)** on the door to secure the door to the **Upper guide rail**.




14. Press the Anti-water strip (14) on the vertical edges of the Stationary glass (02) and the Glass door (05). Also press the Bumper strip (13) on the vertical edge of the Glass door.

Mount the Handle (06) to the Glass door.


Adjust both **Door stoppers (01)** to ensure that they are positioned upright and the **Glass door** is in its maximum opening and closing range. Tighten the set screw to fasten them in place.

15. Apply Kitchen & Bath silicone at both ends of the **Anti-splash threshold (15)**, around the **Guide block (12)** and around the **Threshold bracket (16)**.



16. Apply Kitchen & Bath silicone along the connection of the Stationary glass with the wall and the shower base or the threshold.

## **Product Maintenance**

To ensure long lasting life for your acrylic back walls, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could scratch or dull the surface.

To ensure long lasting life for your glass shower products, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either soft cloth or squeegee to prevent soap buildup. Never use abrasive cleaners and cleaning products that contain scouring agents as this may scratch the surface. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges.

To ensure a long lasting hardware finish, wipe off the metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent finish peeling or corrosion. After cleaning the shiny finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with soft cloth. Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish, work with (not against/across) the grain. Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brushes.






## **Preparation**

- 1. Prior to installation, examine all boxes and packages for shipping damage and compare the piece count with your packing slip. After opening all boxes and packages, read this introduction carefully. Check that all of the needed parts are included in the package by checking off the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Shower Door Components". If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or has missing parts, please contact our customer support department within 5 business days of the delivery date. Please note that DreamLine™ will not replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 10 business days or if the product has been installed. Feel free to contact DreamLine™ if you have any questions, and please provide an order number, job name or other proof of purchase to help us identify your original order.
- 2. Install all of the required plumbing and drainage before installing the shower base. **Use a** competent and licensed (if required by local code) plumber for all plumbing installation.
- 3. Shower bases must be installed by a licensed plumber. Please note that you should consult your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project.
- 4. Please insure that prior to the installation the installation surface is leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right angles. While some adjustment in leveling of the tray is possible, irregular installation surface level or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Please, note that some adjustments may be necessary during the installation process.








## SINGLE THRESHOLD SHOWER BASE <u>Right-Hand Drain Configuration</u>






## **Shower Base Installation - Preparation**

 Ensure that the floor and the studs are at right angles. Provide a 5"×5" opening in the subfloor for the drain. The 2" PVC waste pipe should extend above the surface of the sub-floor according to the drain installation instructions and the height of the Shower base. Refer to the product drawings and tables in these installation instructions for the drain location.








Install the shower drain (NOT INCLUDED) according to the drain installation manual (supplied with the drain).
See Fig. 3 for example



3. Place the tray into the designated position so that the Drain Body drops around the Drain Pipe and butt the Shower Base up against the studs.



Lower the base over the drain pipe and set it into place against the studs.

4. Level the tray and place marks on the studs above the upper edge of the tile flange.




5. Mix the bedding material (Mortar, cement-sand mix, etc.) **Concrete or plaster is not recommended**. Apply enough bedding material to support the entire bottom of the shower base. This will add additional stability and prevent the base from shifting position.

See Fig. 6 for details.





6. After the bedding material has been poured and *before* it sets, place the shower base into the position with the drain assembly sliding over the PVC waste pipe. It will be necessary to push the shower base until the top of the tile flange aligns with the marks drawn on the studs and the front edge is contacting the rough floor along the entire length of the shower base. Ensure that the base is level in all directions. You may need to use shims to hold the tray in the level until the bedding settles and supports the tray. Remove all excess mortar.



7. Allow the bedding material to completely harden before applying weight to the bottom of the shower base.

Install the cement board (or the wallboard) above the tile flanges and secure it to the studs. Put the tiles (or other finishing wall material) over the cement board leaving 1/8" gap between the bottom of the tile and the splash rim of the shower base. Use caulk to fill that gap. See Fig. 8 and Fig. 9 for details.




