GENERAL INSTALLATION INFORMATION

Carefully uncrate and inspect your new bath for any shipping damage. If such damage is found, report it to your vendor immediately. After inspection and during installation, protect the bath from construction damage. Before installation, and before enclosing with wallboard, tile, etc., the bath must be filled with water to check for leaks that may have resulted from shipping damage or mishandling! Fittings (bath filler, shower arm, etc.) are not provided with the bath and must be ordered separately. Framing and enclosing materials are provided by others. Follow test procedures carefully.

ATTENTION INSTALLER!

THIS TUB MUST BE TESTED FOR OPERATION AND LEAKS PRIOR TO ENCLOSURE OF SURROUNDING AREAS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL VOID WARRANTY. THIS TUB WAS WATER TESTED AT THE FACTORY AND FOUND TO BE FULLY OPERATIONAL AND LEAK FREE PRIOR TO SHIPPING. FREIGHT HANDLING AND JOB SITE EXPOSURE MAY HAVE DETERIORATED THE TUB'S CONDITION. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INSTALLER TO THOROUGHLY TEST THE UNIT PRIOR TO INSTALLATION. TUBS ARE INTENDED FOR INDOOR USE ONLY.

TEST PROCEDURES:

- 1. Place the tub on a flat surface such as a driveway.
- 2. Seal the drain.
- 3. Fill tub and allow tub to stand for five minutes. Examine all fittings carefully for leaks. **NOTE:** The overflow is a plumbing device designed to prevent water from reaching a certain level in your tub. DO NOT, under any circumstances, tape off or block the overflow in any way.
- 4. If any leaks or operating problems are discovered, do not complete installation until problems are resolved. DXV by American Standard will not be responsible for any costs involved with removing or reinstalling the tub, or for the costs of any surrounding materials or labor.

If you have installation or warranty questions please do not return the unit to the place of purchase. Call 800-227-2734.

Always protect tub from construction damage by using a protective cover. Damage, including chips and scratches incurred at the jobsite is excluded from warranty but may be repaired by qualified technician at the owner's expense. Do not stand in the tub or store materials in the tub during construction. Do not store tub in temperatures below 32 degrees Fahrenheit.

Protect all finished surfaces of the bathtub during construction and installation using a drop cloth.

The drain outlet is directly under the drain hole in the tub.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Place the tub on a finished, level floor in the desired location.

Using an erasable pencil or marker, trace the outline of the base of the tub on the floor. (See Fig. 1)




Using the adjustable feet on the underside of the tub, ensure that the tub is level.

Ensure that there is a gap between the tub base and the floor. Gap shall not exceed 1/8" [3 mm]. (See Fig. 2)




REMOVE THE TUB

Using the traced outline for reference, confirm that the drain/waste outlet in the floor will align with the tub drain outlet.

(Tub drain outlet will be located in the center of the traced outline. See Fig. 3)

Note: The drain/waste outlet must be installed in accordance with all local building codes.

All drain connections must be made using an access created beneath the tub.





INSTALLING THE 1-1/2" DIAMETER TAIL PIECE ASSEMBLY INTO P-TRAP

The tail piece assembly, consisting of a flanged tail piece, drain tail piece gasket and slip-joint nut used to connect the tub drain to the drain/waste outlet, is included with this product.

The 1-1/2" diameter tail piece is compatible with drain provided. (See Fig. 4)


Slide the slip-joint nut over tail piece towards the flanged end as shown.

Slide the P-trap slip-joint nut and seal over the tail piece as shown.

Insert the tail piece into the P-trap.

The flange of the tail piece should be approximately 5-3/4" [145 mm] or 4-7/8" [124 mm] depending on model, above the finished floor when fully inserted into the P-trap.

The tail piece can be cut if necessary.



Apply a generous bead of silicone caulking to the base of the tub. (See Fig. 5)

Carefully set the tub into position. Ensure that drain tail piece gasket is fully seated against the tail piece flange.

Connect the tail piece to the tub drain. Tighten all of the drain connections. Remove any excess caulking where the tub meets the floor.

Note: Connecting the tail piece assembly to the drain will require access from beneath the tub.

Fill the tub with water and drain. Check for leaks and re-tighten connections as necessary.

Apply a bead of Tub & Tile caulk around the bottom edge of the tub where it meets the floor. Remove any excess caulking.

FIXTURES

No fixtures can be mounted on the tub deck of freestanding tubs. Floor or wall-mounted fixtures are required.

Wall-Mounted - The position of the tub and the reach of the spout are critical. Pay special attention to the spout reach when choosing your fixtures. Be careful to ensure the spout will extend out far enough to clear the tub flange and the falling water will not hit too high up on the side wall of the tub and splash.

Floor-Mounted - Some freestanding fixtures must be anchored to the tub drain for stabilization. The waste and overflow on freestanding tubs are concealed so anchoring to the overflow pipe (or tub structure) is not possible. Many kits (with minor modification) can be mounted to the wall (rather than the drain pipe) for stabilization.
