The metal frame and crystal components of this chandelier are very delicate. Please exercise extreme caution during unpacking and installation.

WARNING!!!

After passing the main electrical wire through the 10mm pipe and connecting the pipe to the main body top connector, place all remaining pieces as shown in numerical order and in the orientation depicted. Refer to the parts list to avoid confusion between parts. The part numbers coincide.

CAUTION

- 1. Rated 110-130V/60Hz, bulb 20W maximum
- Care should be taken to avoid demage to the surface of lighting and wire, wearing gloves is recommended when installing.
- 3. Connect black or red wire of the lighting to live wire and white or blue wire to neutral wire and double colored(or bare copper)wire to ground wire.
- 4. Never install lighting on deep ceiling, the room should be dry and well ventilated.
- 5. Keep lighting away from acid, alkali and other corrosive chemical or gas, clean the lighting with clean soft cloth only.
- 6. Installation must be carried out by qualified electricism only.
- 7. Disconnect the power before installing cleaning and replacing lighting.
- 8. Never cover the lighting when power is connected.
- 9. Firmness must be secured when installing ceiling tube, chain, pipe and other connecting parts.
- 10. Care should be taken to avoid damage when installing glass parts.
- 11. All electrical components must be installed by a licensed electrician and in accordance with the National Electrical Code and the appropriate local electrical codes. Make sure that the electrical supply to the chandelier is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker before doing any installation.





- 1 . Attach (Straight pipe) 02 to (Cylindrical coppe) 03.
- 2 . Install (Net Canopy)01 to the electic Box and wire properly.
- 3. Use the sleeve that come with the (G4 bulb)04 or use cotton cloth when handle the (G4 bulb)04. Please do not touch (G4 bulb)04 with bare hands.
- 4 . Apply (straight iron wire) 06 to (ball) 05

- ZA. Juntion Box (not supplied)
- ZB. Ceiling Plate
- ZC. Box Screws
- ZD. Junction Caps
- ZE. Electric Main
- ZF. Ground Wire
- ZG. Ceiling Screws
- ZH. Nets canopy
- 1. Attach the Ceiling Plate (B) to the Juntion Box (A) using the four Box screws (C) which are not supplied and should already be in your box.
- 2. Be sure when connecting the wire use electrician approved junction caps(D).
- 3. Stow the excess wire in the juntion box(A).
- 4. Raise the nets canopy (H).
- 5. Attach the nets canopy (H) to the ceiling plate (B) using the three ceiling screws (G).
