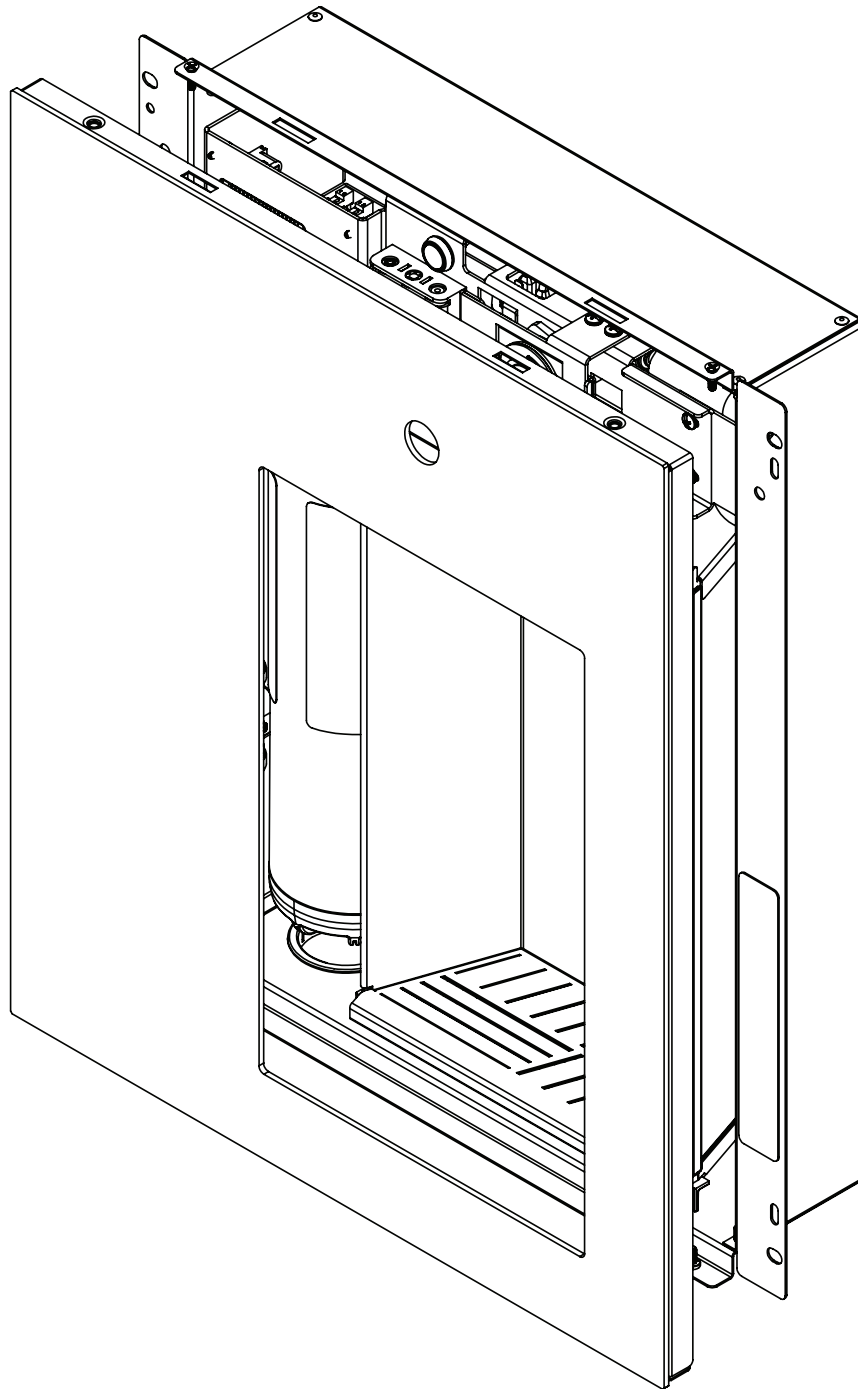

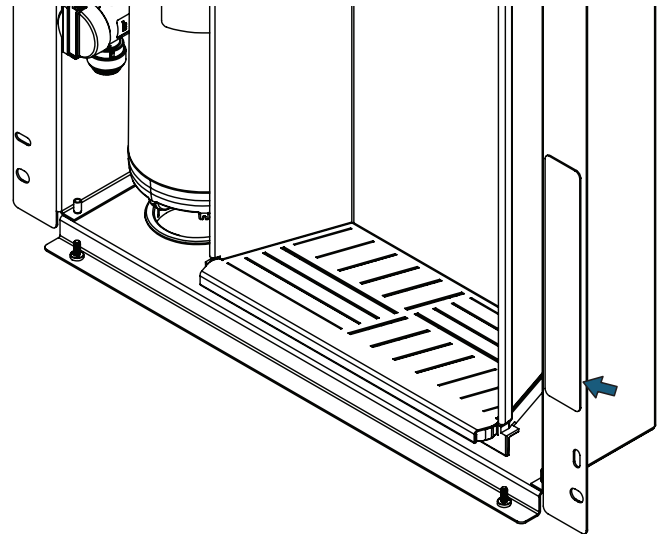

Preparing to Install

For correct and safe installation, please read these instructions completely.

⚠ DANGER

Disconnect electrical supply serving the installation area to reduce risk of electrocution. Unit not suitable for installations where water jets might be used.

⚠ WARNING

- Shut off water supply serving the installation area to reduce risk of water damage
- Flush all water lines and fittings before connecting to your water dispenser
- Warranty is void if installation is not performed in accordance with current manufacturing instructions

⚠ CAUTION

Hose sets are not to be used for connecting the water dispenser to water mains. If inlet pressure is above 105 psi (0.72 MPa), a pressure regulator must be installed in the water supply line. Any damage caused by connecting this product to a water supply line with a pressure outside its rated pressure is not covered by warranty.

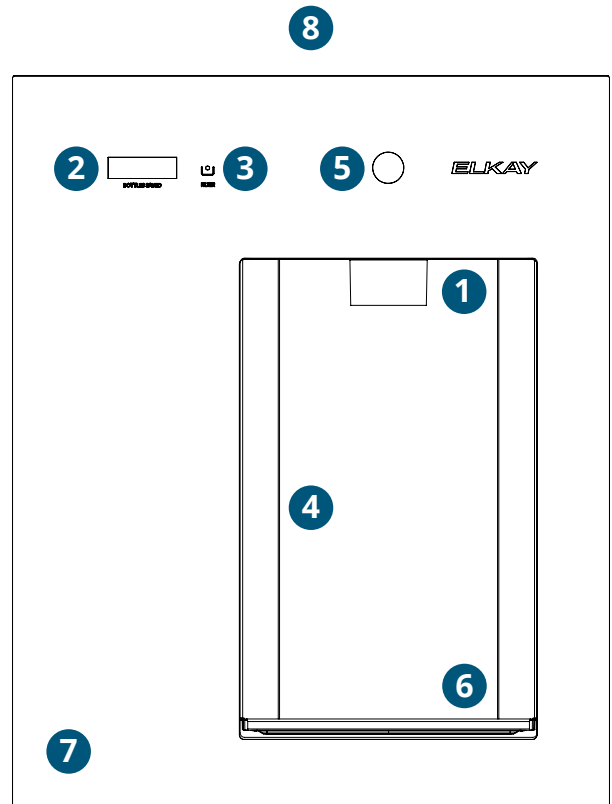
⚠ NOTICE

- This water dispenser is designed for indoor use only and should not be installed outdoors, on exterior walls or in a humid environment
- Make sure the water supply pressure to the product is between 40 and 105 psi to avoid damage; product used with filter requires 40 psi, but 60 psi is optimal. Noise level is lower than 70 dB
- Use care when opening and removing the packaging to prevent damage to the product
 - Inspect the product for any shipping damage and report it immediately to the location of purchase. Installation of a damaged product will void the warranty
 - Confirm you've received all included parts for proper installation of this product. Contact the location of purchase if damaged parts are found or parts are missing
- Make sure no electrical wiring, potable water inlet pipes or drain water outlet pipes will be damaged during installation of the product

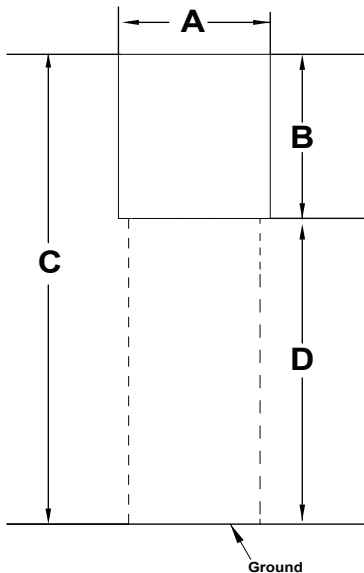
Critical Depth Check and Mounting Dimensions

Make sure the wall cavity is deep enough to house the water dispenser (dimension E). Water dispenser is 3-1/2" (89 mm) deep.



Dimension E is a minimum depth requirement.

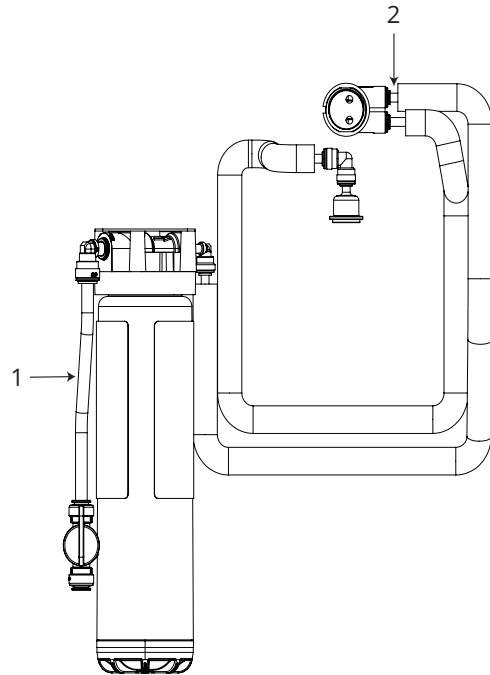
Recommended Dimensions



- A- Unit width opening should be 14-1/2" (368 mm) wide
- B- Unit height opening should be 19-1/2" (495-3/10 mm)
- C- Suggested unit height from the floor is 59-2/5" (1,508 mm)
- D- Optional cut from bottom of water dispenser to floor for plumbing access

Plumbing Connections

- 1 - 3/8" flexible water tubing
- 2 - 1/4" flexible water tubing

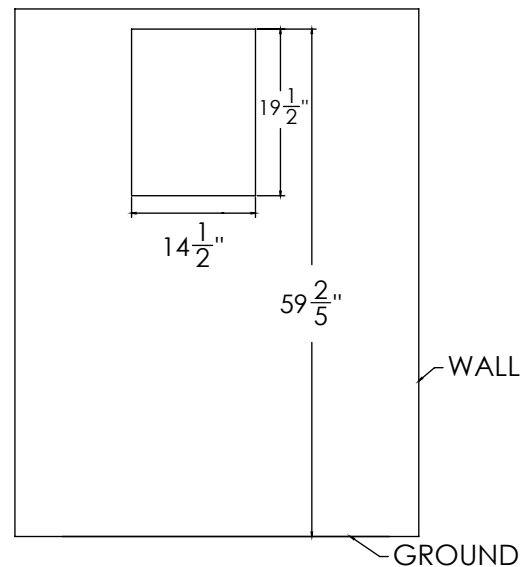


Note: Always consult local plumbing codes prior to installation.

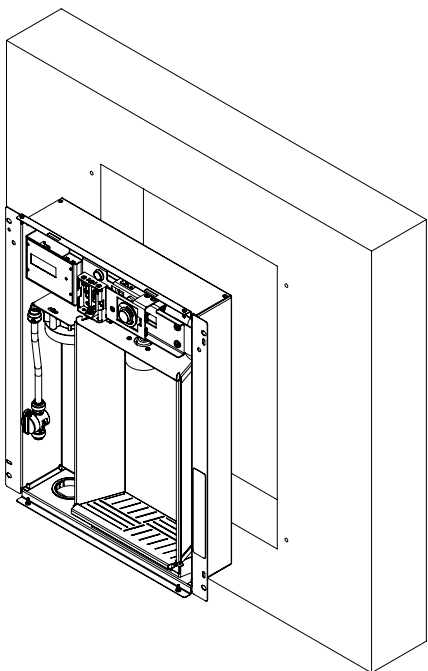
Installation

Preinstallation: Elkay recommends installing a shutoff valve at the source of the water supply for the water dispenser.

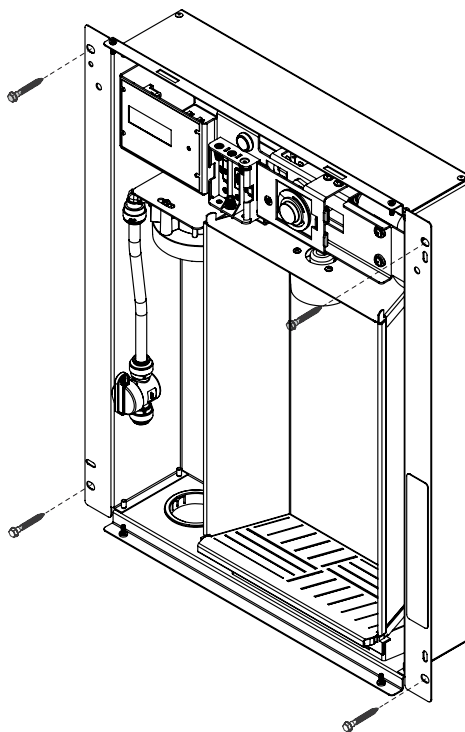
1. Cut an opening into the wall using the recommended mounting dimensions as a guide: 19-1/2"H x 14-1/2"W; recommended height from floor is 59-2/5".



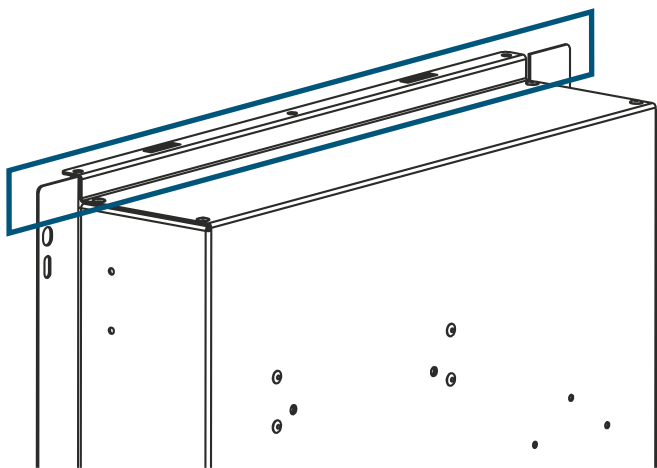
2. Route the 3/8" water line through the designated opening at the base of the dispenser. Carefully tilt the dispenser to position it within the wall cavity.



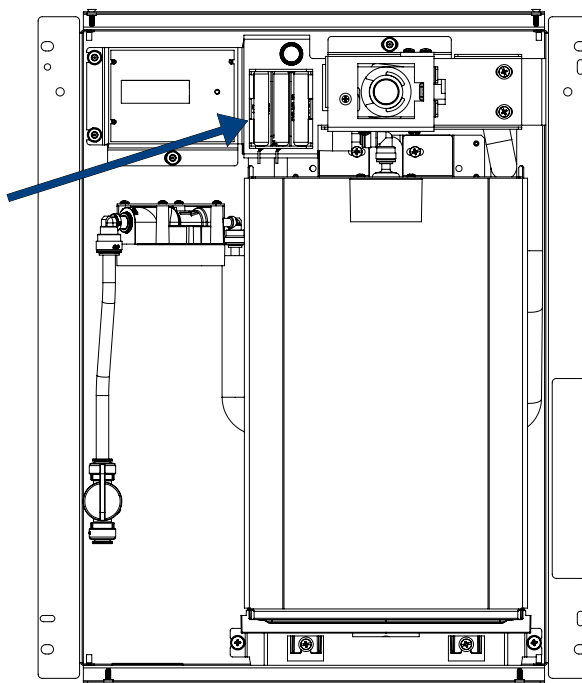
4. Using a bubble level, straighten the water dispenser and attach it to the wall studs using (4) screws (not included).



3. Place the water dispenser into the wall cavity and slide it up against the drywall at the top of the opening. The unit is designed with 1/4" overlap to conceal any irregularities at the top of the wall opening.



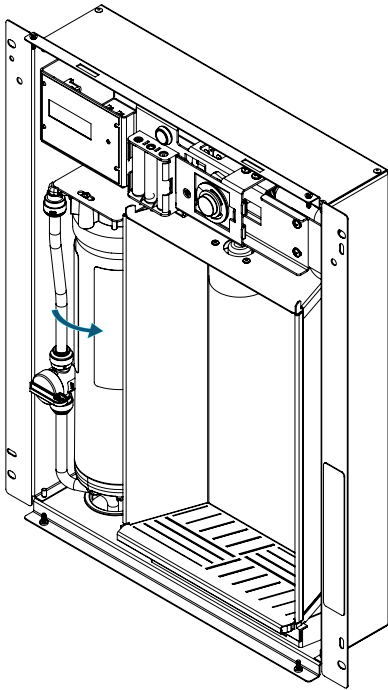
5. Install 3-AA batteries



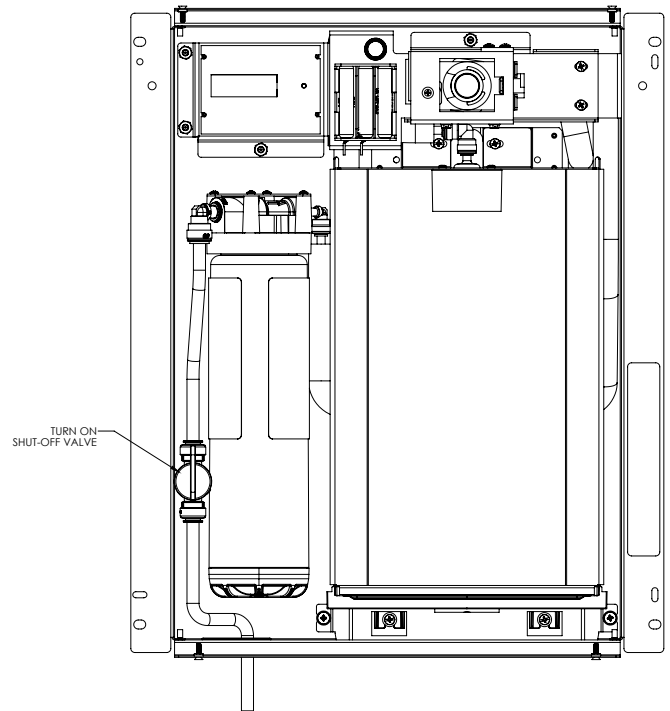
Startup

Prepare for First Use

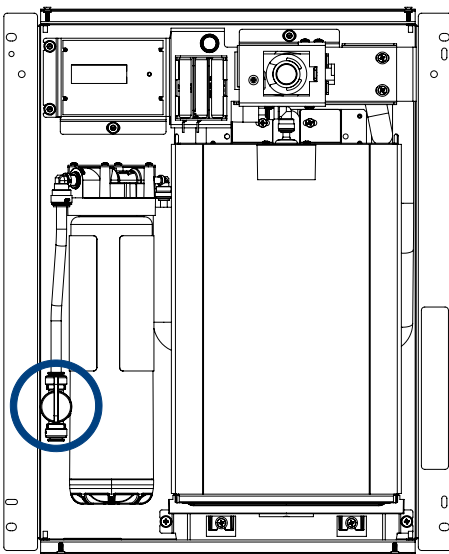
6. Install the new filter by inserting it into the filter head and turning it clockwise to lock in place.



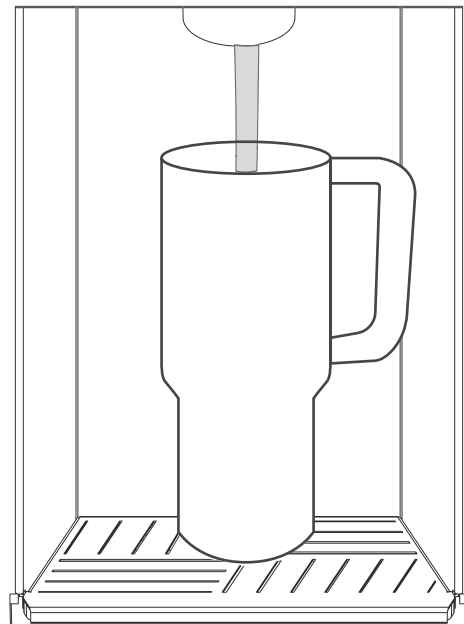
1. Open the shutoff valves in the water dispenser and at the water supply. Check for any water leaks.

8. Connect the 3/8" water line to the shutoff valve, located at the filter's inlet.

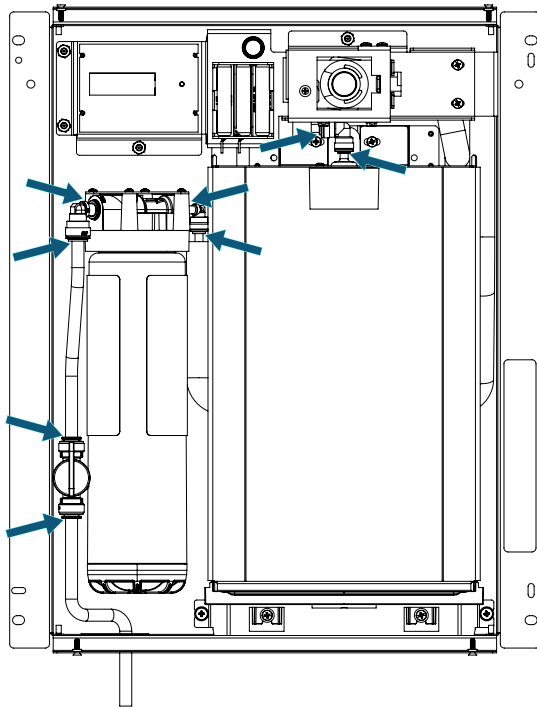


2. Place a container under the water dispenser spout and push the button to dispense at least one gallon of water. This is to release any trapped air from the supply lines and filter and to flush fine carbon particles from the filter.

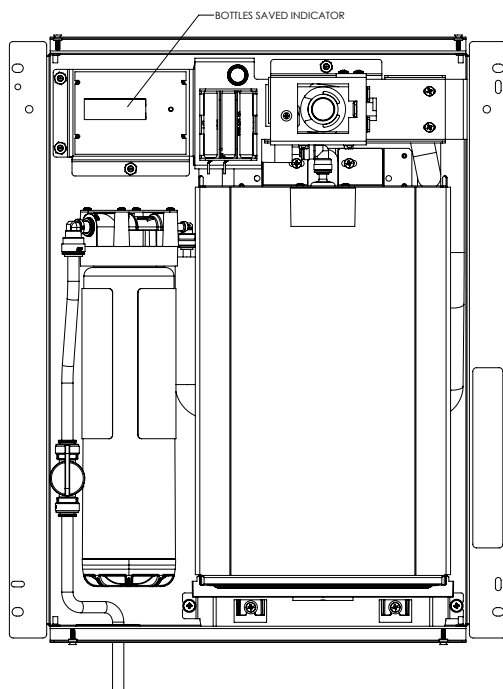


Follow startup instructions on the next page to start enjoying your new Liv EZ water dispenser.

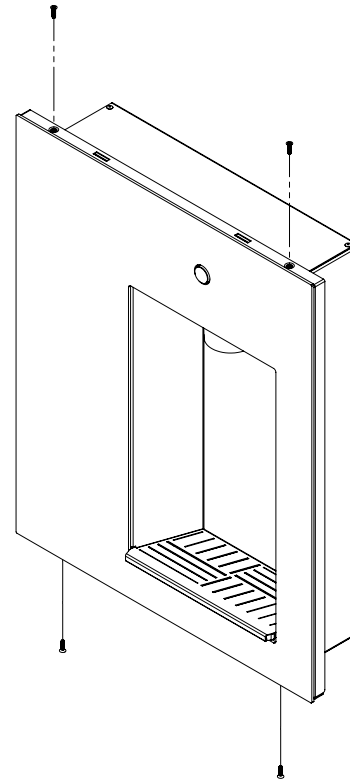
3. Check for any water leaks.



4. Upon initial startup, the Bottles Saved indicator panel will display a number proportionate to the amount of water used during startup.



5. Attach the water dispenser glass front cover using the Phillips Head screwdriver and (4) included Phillips head screws. Your Liv EZ is ready to be used - enjoy!



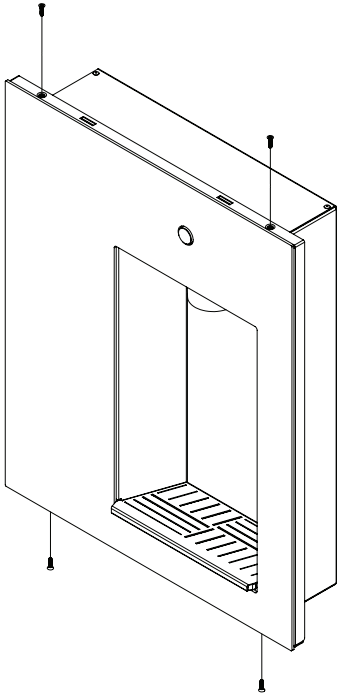
Filter Status Light

The red LED filter status indicator will illuminate during dispense when the life of the filter has reached 91.6% or is depleted and needs to be replaced:

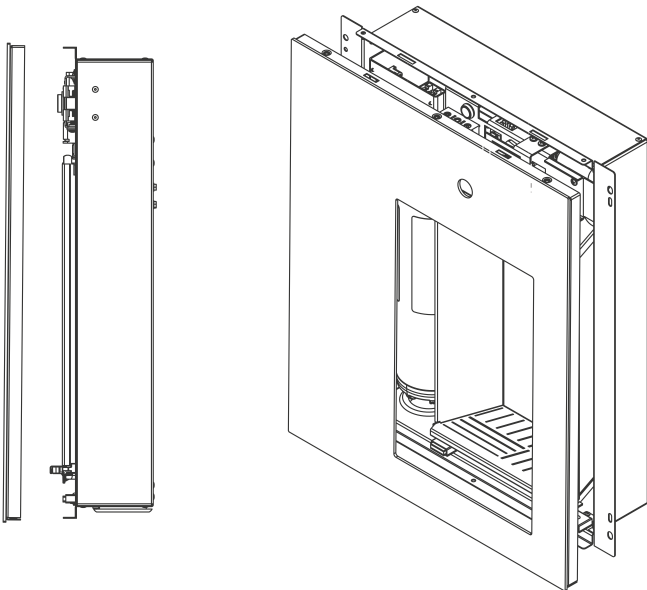
- Pulsing red light: Indicates more than 91.6% of the filter has been used or approximately 11 months of usage
 - LED fades on for two seconds and off for three seconds
- Solid red light: Indicates 100% of the filter has been used or approximately 12 months of usage. Filter must be replaced
 - LED remains lit for the duration of dispense
 - When unit is inactive, LED blinks twice, pauses for ten seconds, then blinks twice again. Cycle repeats for 30 minutes until the filter is replaced and the light is reset

Replacing the Filter and Batteries

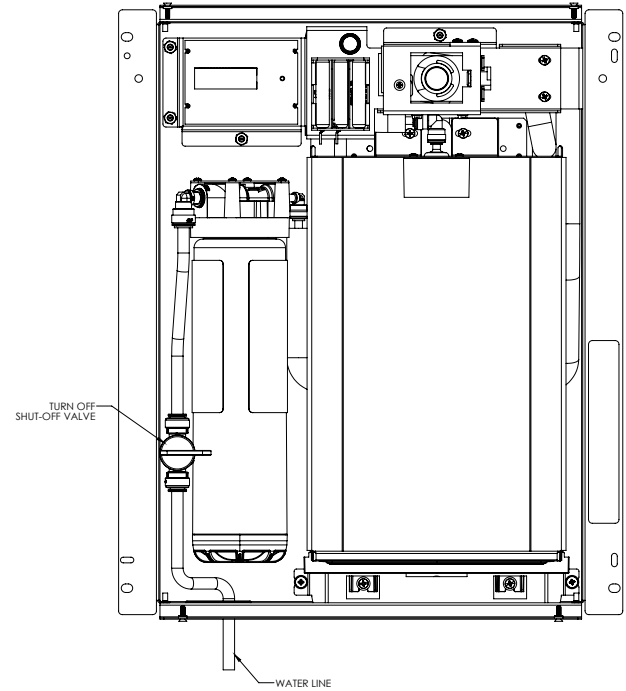
1. Remove the screws from the top and bottom of the front panel.



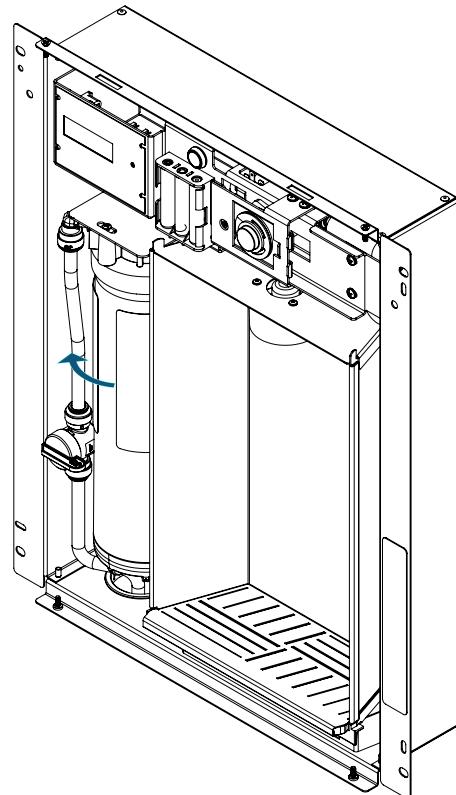
2. Rotate the door gently to loosen it and pull it toward you to remove. Set aside.



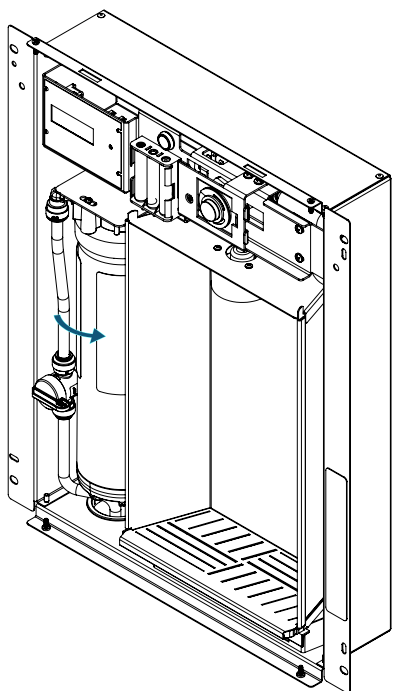
3. Turn off the water supply.



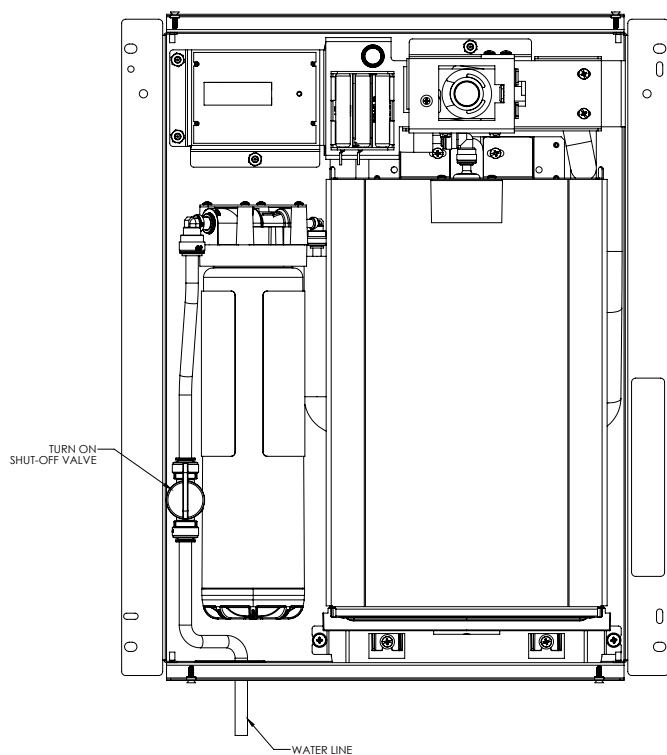
4. Rotate the filter counterclockwise to release it.



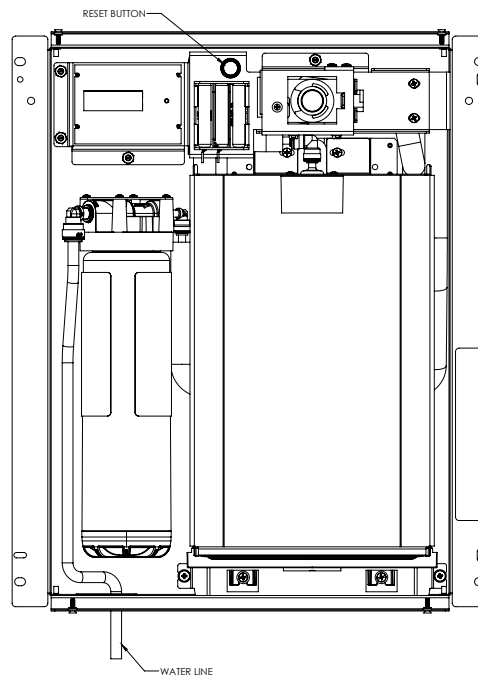
5. Install the new filter by inserting it into the filter head and turning it clockwise to lock in place. Remove existing 3 AAA batteries and replace with new



6. Turn on the water supply.



7. Push the reset button to access the menu and reset the filter light.



Reset Filter Status Light and Battery Replacement

After replacing the filter, reset the light by pressing the reset button above the battery compartment (p.9).

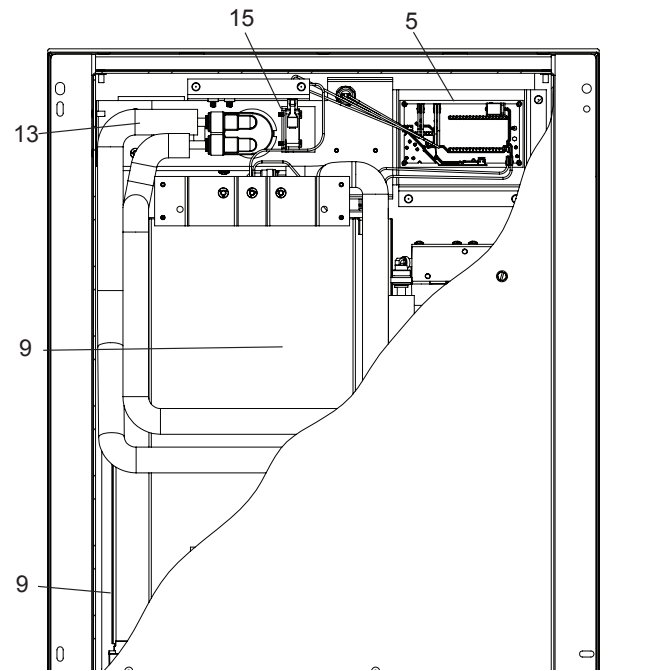
1. Press and hold the button: HLD 3SEC will appear on the LCD screen.
2. After pressing the button for three seconds, FLTR RST will appear on the screen.
3. Replace batteries and filter once a year.

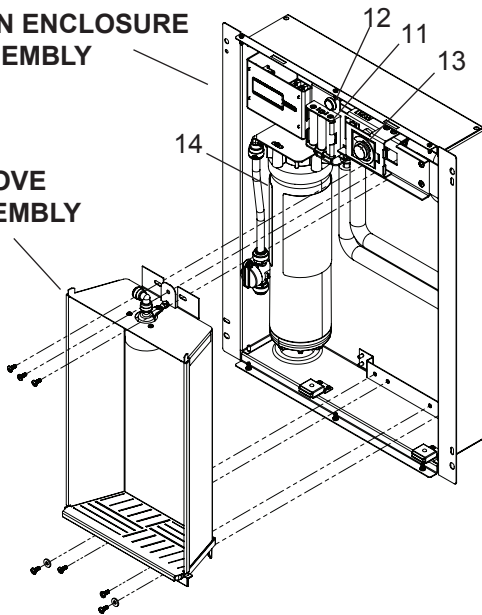
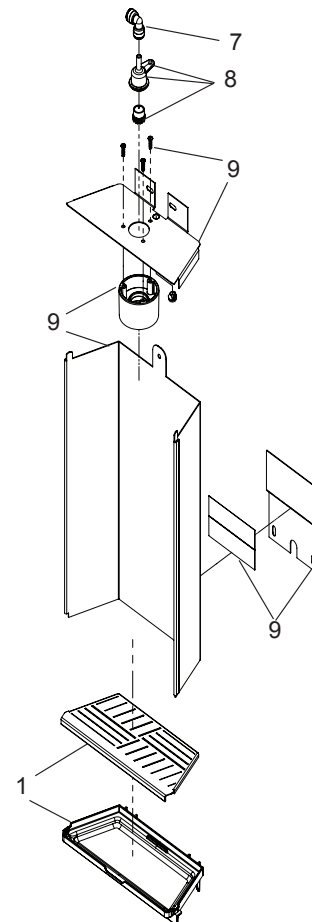

Troubleshooting

Issue	Possible Cause	Remedy
Low water flow	Water supply pressure is less than what is required	Water pressure must be between 40 and 105 psi
	Filter is unplugged	Replace filter
No water flow	Water shut-off valve(s) are closed	Open all shut-off valves (one is located inside the filter box if filter is installed, and another may be located at the water source)
	Blocked or damaged water line	Locate affected line and remove blockage or damage
