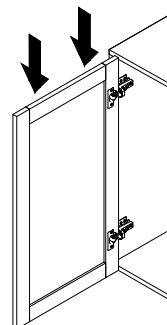
## Uneven Doors



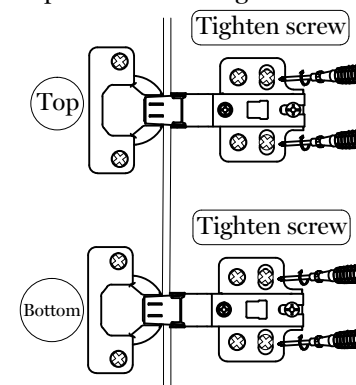
- 1 Loosen "up & down screw" of the top and bottom hinge a little.



- 2 Lower the height of the door so that the two doors are of the same height.



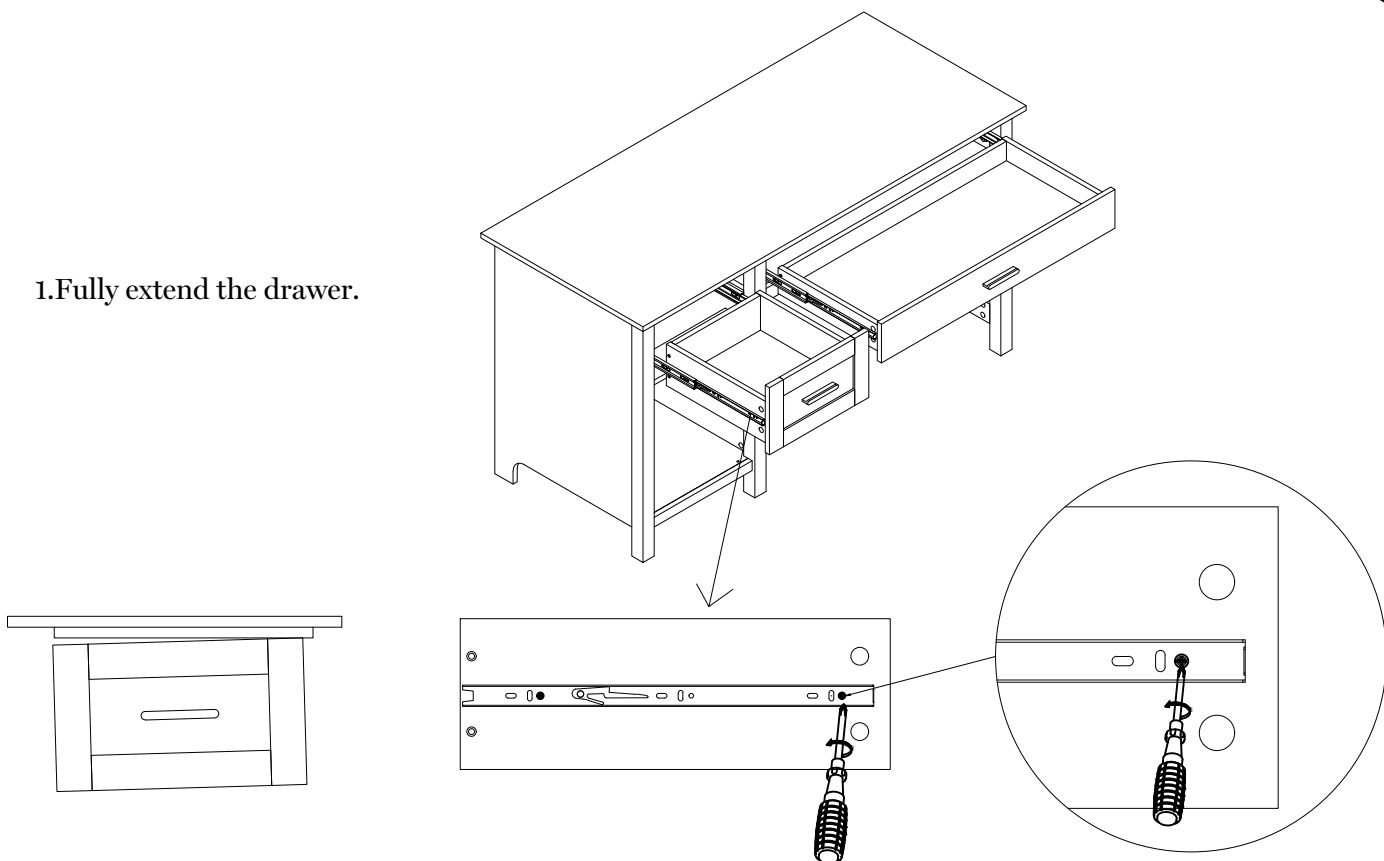
- 3 Tighten "up & down screw" of the top and bottom hinge.



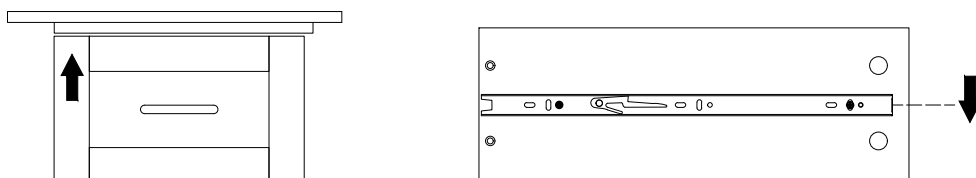

# Drawer Adjustment Instructions

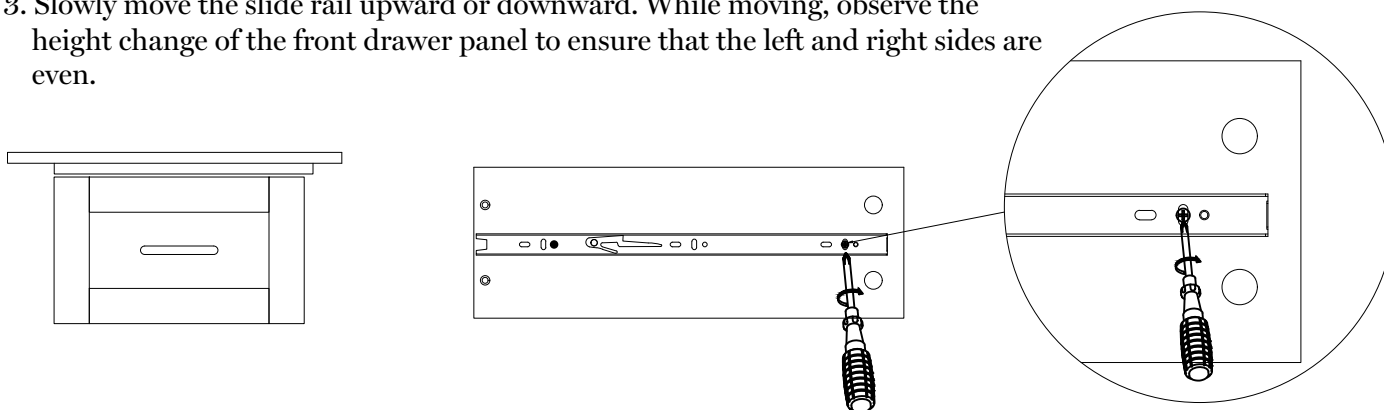
1. Fully extend the drawer.



2. Loosen the screw from the second hole position and remove it.



3. Slowly move the slide rail upward or downward. While moving, observe the height change of the front drawer panel to ensure that the left and right sides are even.



4. When the left and right sides are level, insert the screw into the third hole section and tighten the screw. Check the stability and height consistency of the front drawer panel again to ensure that the adjustment achieves the expected effect.

※ If the front drawer panel is still not level, repeat the above steps on the other side of the drawer.
