Always turn off water supply before removing existing showerhead or replacing any part. Open the valve handle to relieve water pressure and ensure that water is completely shut off.

To preserve the finish of your showerhead, apply nonabrasive wax. Any cleaners should be rinsed off immediately. Do not use abrasive cleaners on the showerhead.






Thread Sealant Tape







Remove the old showerhead from the existing shower arm by turning the ball joint counterclockwise.



Flush the lines without the showerhead to remove debris before installing showerhead.



Apply thread sealant tape in a clockwise direction to the open end of the shower arm.



Carefully use a wrench on the thread flats of the ball joint to tighten. Do not overtighten.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	CORRECTIVE ACTION
	Water nozzles are blocked with mineral	Gently rub easy clean nozzles with fingertip to remove
Uneven water flow	build-up or debris	any mineral build-up or debris
	Mineral build-up or debris have clogged	
Low water flow	the screen in the ball joint	Rinse the mineral build-up or debris from the screen
