


## Installation Instructions For Use With KB's Straight Stop

### Instructions:

- 1. Apply thread sealant tape to threads (1).
- 2. Screw valve body (2) onto pipe (3).
- 3. Place nut (4) and ring (5) on tube (6).
- 4. Insert tube (6) into valve.
- 5. Wrench tighten nut (4) onto valve.
- 6. Stop any leaks by tightening nuts slightly.



## Installation Instructions For Use With KB's Decorative P-Trap

## **Instructions**:


- 1. Remove horizontal leg and slip joint from bottle trap.
- 2. Apply teflon to all exposed threads.
- 3. Insert slip joint nut(3) and waste cover(4) onto horizontal leg(6).
- 4. Insert horizontal leg into wall waste opening, do not tighten.
- 5. Insert black rubber washer(2) and slip joint nut(1)onto tail piece(8).
- 6. Attach bottle trap(7) to tail piece and hand tighten slip pint nut(1).
- 7. Align bottle trap with horizontal leg and tail piece, at this point it may be necessary to cut part of tail piece or part of horizontal leg to obtain proper alignment.
- 8. After all components have been properly aligned, insert horizontal leg making sure to insert black washer(5) before tightening slip pint nut
- 9. Thread both slip joint nuts onto bottle trap and tighten along with slip joint securing horizontal leg to wall waste opening.
- 10. Check for leakage by opening faucet and letting water run for at least 45 seconds.





### Installation manual for hand shower:




1. Put a washer to the cone shape hose nut and hand tightens the hand shower clockwise.




2. Turn on the water and check for leaks, if the hand shower leaks at the connection to the hose, hand tighten the connection some more.

### Installation manual for pull-out & pull-down sprayer:




1. Thread hose to spray head and feed from the top into the faucet spout, turn the spout to the right or to the left fully to facilitate the insertion of the hose.



2. After applying teflon tape thread other end of hose to spray hose outlet, located underneath the faucet. Remove sprayhead and let water run for at least one minute to eject any debris remaining on the line, reinstall sprayhead.



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS For Use With KB's Hand Shower Sets, Showerhead Sets and Kitchen Sprayer


#### Before installation:

Hold the existing shower arm up and down to ensure the plumbing behind the wall is rigid to hold the weight of the new shower unit - about 3-4 lbs when filled with water.


### Installation manual for shower arm & showerhead:




1. Place the flange into the shower rod.




2. Wrap threads on one end of shower rod or the plumbing male nipple with 3 wraps of Teflon tape.




3. Thread the male nipple into female nipple (in wall), tighten with pipe wrench.




4. Turn the water on and check for leaks, any leaks will require minor tightening or adjustment.




5. Wrap teflon tape around all the threads on shower rod and hand tighten the showerhead clockwise.




6. Turn the water on and check for leaks, any leaks will require minor tightening or adjustment. If the showerhead leaks at the connection to the thread shower arm, tighten the connection some more by using a wrench.




### Installation manual for deck mount sprayer:




1. For model with spray head and hose, place the spray guide through the fourth hole in the sink, screw the locknut onto the shank and tighten firmly.



2. Place rubber washer to end of spray hose and attach sprayer.



3. Connect spray hose to hose outlet located underneath the faucet.



4. Set sprayer on base and sprayer is ready to use.
