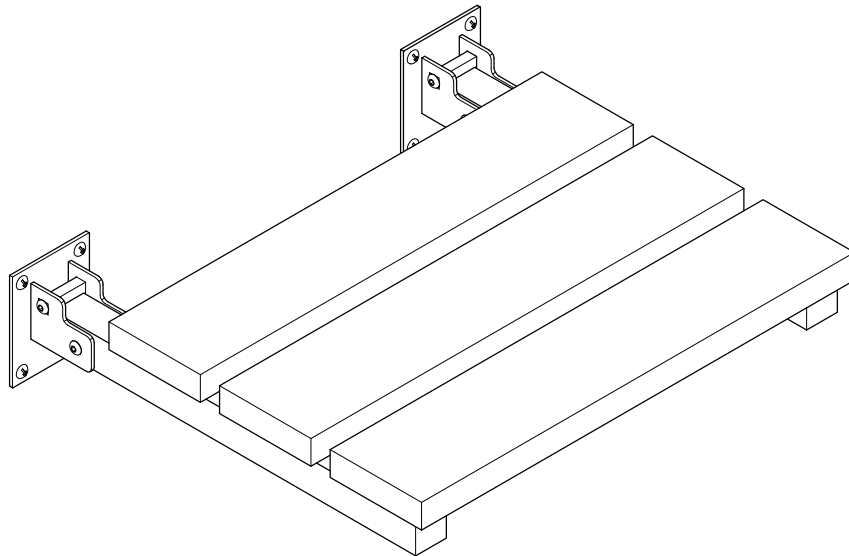


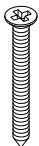


Shower Seat Wall Mount Hinged Installation Instructions

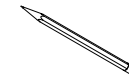

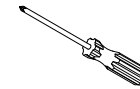

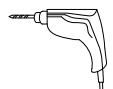
Allen Wrench

Before Installation:

For your own safety, this seat should be installed by a licensed professional. It is recommended that this seat be properly secured to 2" x 6" piece of lumber or larger as wood bracing.

Weight limit on this seat is 120 kgs (265 lbs) max.

Installation Steps:

- Step 1.** Locate the desired seating position. To comply with ADA standards, seat should be mounted at a height where the seating surface in its downward position is at a height of 17" to 19" above finished floor. Please check all State and Local code for building requirements.
- Step 2.** Place seat at its desired location, make sure the seating surface is level, use a pencil to mark the locations for the screw holes from each mounting plate on the wall. Remove the seat after marking the locations of the mounting holes.
- Step 3.** Drive all the screws in at the marked locations then remove all the screws from the wall.
- Step 4.** Place seat back and align the mounting plates with the pre-drilled screw holes. Drive in all the screws again to secure the seat firmly on the wall.
- Step 5.** Make sure that the seat raises and lowers smoothly. If correctly installed, the seat will remain in the upward, closed position on its own, and will require minimal effort to be lowered down to the seating position.
