Prior to Installation:

- Make sure that you have all necessary parts by checking the parts list. If any part is missing or damaged, please contact Kraus Customer Service at 800-775-0703 for a replacement.
- Inspect the sink prior to installation to make sure that it has not been damaged during shipping.
- Read all instructions and safety warnings and ensure you have all tools, parts, and equipment necessary for a safe installation.
- Use the cut-out template provided by Kraus.
- Observe all plumbing and building codes according to your state requirements.
- To reduce the risk of personal injury, wear eye protection complying with ANSI standard Z87.1+ and cut resistant gloves complying with EN388 with non-slip grip when cutting or drilling, or when handling the sink and wear closed toe shoes at all times during installation.
- Note: Maximum countertop thickness for Top Mount installation is 1 3/4".
- Note: Before installation, please check that the drain kit complies with ASME A112.18.2/CSA B125.2 and with CUPC certification.



While these step-by-step instructions are intended to assist in the safe installation of a Kraus sink, this product is likely to perform best when installed by a licensed professional. The failure to follow these instructions or to hire a professional when needed may result in personal injury or property damage and may void the warranty.

Cleaning & Maintenance:

Clean your sink on a regular basis with warm soapy water. Rinse the sink after using cleaning products. Wipe the sink surface with a soft cloth to remove any liquid residue. Do not cut food directly on the surface of the sink. Do not leave sharp objects on the surface of the sink for an extended period of time. Do not use abrasive cleaning products, sanding tools, steel wool or bleaching products as use of such products may affect product performance or void the warranty.

Tools you will need



NOTE: Specialized tools may be necessary to install Kraus Quartz Composite Kitchen sinks with countertop materials other than wood, marble or granite.

Important

- Instructions may vary depending on countertop material. Read all instructions carefully, and ensure that counters are compatible with sink installation before proceeding.
- Follow the plumber's code and builder's code effective in your area.
- Shut off water valves prior to installation.
- Open sink packaging and verify that the sink is in perfect condition. Put sink back into packaging to protect it until time of installation.
- To replace an existing sink, make sure that the cut-out hole in the counter is of an adequate size to fit the new sink.







Step 1. Position Template


- Check the cut-out template against the actual sink to ensure a proper sized cut-out.
- Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop.

NOTE: Make sure clearance is suitable for backsplash, faucet, and plumbing for the sink.



Step 2. Trace Template

• Trace template on countertop with a pencil.




Step 3. Cut Countertop

• Cut the opening in the countertop by carefully following the traced line.

CAUTION - To avoid the risk of personal injury, wear safety glasses and cut resistant gloves with non-slip grip when cutting.





NOTE: Please use the appropriate saw that best fits your countertop material.












Step 4. Cut Cabinet Front

• Measure height of apron front. Add 1/16" to the dimension when you mark base cabinet front cutout. Use jigsaw to cut.

CAUTION - To avoid the risk of personal injury, wear safety glasses and cut resistant gloves with non-slip grip when cutting.






Step 5. Add Additional Faucet Holes (Optional)

- Determine the location of the faucet.
- Place the sink upside down on a suitable flat surface.
- Using the 35mm (1 3/8") diamond hole saw at high power (1500tr. per break through in the desired location.

CAUTION: This procedure will cause the metal saw to become very hot. Please handle with care.



Step 6. Attach Mounting Hardware


• Insert the anchors (pre-attached to the mounting hardware) into the sink holes with flat side against the sink and tighten the screws.





Step 7. Install Sink

- Clean and dry the surface around the opening of the sink.
- Verify that the sink fits correctly in the opening. The edge of the sink must sit on the counter.
- Turn the unit upside down to apply sealant. Apply silicone-based sealant (not included) underneath the edge of the sink.
- Ensure that the plastic flap holding the screw underneath the sink is partially opened, as shown.
- Insert the sink into the opening.
- Fix the sink to the counter by swiveling the mounting brackets, as shown.
- Tighten the screws in the front of the sink, followed by the ones in the back and on the sides of the sink.
- Remove excess silicone-based sealant.

NOTE: Please refer to the below to determine your install by countertop thickness. If the plastic insert (B) is needed, remove the film and stick it to the under side of the countertop to accommodate for a thinner countertop.








Step 8. Install Plumbing Fixtures

- Connect drain to sink. Connect trap to drain. Connect water supply connections to faucet according to manufacturer's instructions.
- Run water into sink and check for leaks.



Codes/Standards Applicable



Kitchen Sink - Lifetime Limited Warranty

Kraus' USA Plumbing, LLC ("Kraus") extends this warranty to the original purchaser for personal household use of the Kitchen Sink when purchased from a Kraus authorized dealer and in the location of original installation. This warranty is non-transferable.

Kraus warrants the structure and finish of the Kitchen Sink to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal usage for as long as the original purchaser resides in the residence in which the sink was Kitchen Sink was first installed.

Any product reported to the authorized dealer or to Kraus as being defective within the warranty period will be repaired or replaced with a product of equal value at the option of Kraus.

Commercial Warranty

Kraus USA Plumbing, LLC ("Kraus") warrants its Products for a period of one (1) year to commercial purchasers of Products used in industrial, commercial and business applications.

Care and Cleaning Instructions

Certain cleaning products may cause damage to a Product's finish and use of the following on the Product will void this warranty:

- Abrasive cleaners such as powders, bleach, ammonia, alcohol or chorine
- Abrasive pads, steel wool or wire brushes

This warranty does not cover Products that were discontinued when purchased or display Products, whether such Products were purchased at discount outlets, unauthorized dealers, and/or sold on clearance. This warranty does not cover any free gifts included with purchase.
