Prior to Installation

- CAUTION: To avoid the risk of personal injury, property damage, and product failure, completely read all instructions, warnings, cautions, and maintenance information.
 Failure to do so may void the warranty.
- NOTICE: This product is made of tempered safety glass, which is stronger than normal
 glass, but it can break if damaged. A scratch, chip, or contact with a hard surface can
 cause it to weaken or break. This could, immediately or at a later time, cause the glass to
 loudly shatter into many small pieces without apparent cause. The smaller pieces reduce
 the risk of serious personal injury. DO NOT: Set the sink on a hard surface during
 installation, use tools directly on the sink, install the sink in a manner inconsistent with
 these instructions, or set or lay items weighing more than 75 pounds in or on the sink.

IMPORTANT:

- Unpack your new product and ensure that all the parts are contained in the packaging.
- Keep the product in its original box until you're ready to install it.
- The counter top must be flat.
- Shut off the water supply if replacing a previously installed vessel sink.
- Observe all plumbing and building codes in your area.

IMPORTANT: This product must be installed by a licensed trade professional, such as a contractor, carpenter, or plumber. Failure to use such a professional for installation may void the warranty.

Above Counter Installation Instructions

Before You Begin

Prepare counter top by drilling a 1 3/4" diameter drain hole at the desired location. Install mounting ring. Place vessel sink on the mounting ring or counter top as shown below.

- 1. **CAUTION** Make sure the vessel sink is not scratched, chipped or broken prior to installation. Failure to do so could result in glass breakage and personal injury, property damage, or product failure.
- 2. Check to see if your set contains the following parts:
 - Vessel sink
 - Pop up drain (optional, may be sold separately)
 - Mounting Ring (optional, may be sold separately)
- 3. Locate and place the mounting ring over the drain hole with the rubber side facing down and the white washer side facing up.
- 4. Gently set your sink on top of the mounting ring.



Pop Up Drain & Mounting Ring Installation (Only if Included)

Locate and disassemble your pop up drain in the following order:

- Unscrew the tail piece
- Unscrew the brass nut
- Remove the firm washer
- Remove the concave washer, leaving the top thin rubber washer on.

CAUTION - Misinstalling the pop up drain and mounting ring can compromise the glass, resulting in breakage. To avoid personal injury, property damage, or product failure, follow the instructions for installing these components carefully.



- 1. From above the countertop, insert the drain body into the 1 3/4" drain opening of your sink.
- From underneath the countertop, insert the concave white rubber washer onto the drain.
 CAUTION The white rubber washer protects the glass from making contact with metal components; DO NOT skip this step.
- 3. Push the washer all the way up until it is in contact with the countertop.
- 4. Insert the firm washer onto the drain body until it comes into contact with the concave white rubber washer.
- 5. Screw the brass nut onto the drain body until it touches the firm washer.

AUTION - To avoid glass breakage, DO NOT use a tool and DO NOT over tighten.

Kraus USA Plumbing, LLC ("Kraus") warrants its Products for a period of one (1) year to commercial purchasers of Products used in industrial, commercial and business applications.

<u>What We Will Do</u>: Any product reported to the authorized dealer or to Kraus that proves defective within the warranty period stated above may be repaired or replaced with a product of equal value at the option of Kraus. If repair or replacement is not practical, Kraus may elect to refund the purchase price in exchange for the return of the product. **These are your exclusive remedies**.

Care and Cleaning Instructions

Certain cleaning products may cause damage to a Product's finish and use of the following on the Product will void this warranty:

- · Abrasive cleaners such as powders, bleach, ammonia, alcohol or chorine
- · Abrasive pads, steel wool or wire brushes

What is Not Covered

This warranty does not cover Products that were discontinued at the time of purchase, display Products or Products that were free gifts included with your purchase. In addition, this warranty does not cover Products purchased from discount outlets or unauthorized dealers or Products that were purchased on clearance.
