INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read carefully and save these instructions as you may need them a later date.

CAUTION

WARNING: Risk of Fire. Consult a qualified electrician to ensure correct branch circuit conductor.

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture in order to prevent possible shock.

GENERAL

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C.) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustration.

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

1. Position mounting plate (1) to wall and mark location of two plastic anchors (3). Pre-drill the holes for plastic anchors (3). Insert plastic anchors (3) into wall. Secure the mounting plate (1) to the outlet box with the outlet box screws (2) and plastic anchors (3) and wood screw (4).
 2. Pull out the wires and ground wire from the Outlet Box.
Make wire connections with Wire nut:
 - White wire from light to White Wire from power source.
 - Black wire from light to Black Wire from power source.
 - Wrap the Ground Wire from the light around the green screw on the mounting plate (1), then connect it to the grounding wire from power source.
 3. Align the Back plate (7) to the Outlet box, then use a screwdriver (6) (not included) to secure it to the mounting plate (1) with the mounting screws (5).
 4. To prevent moisture from entering the outlet box and the fixtures mounting plate (1) causing ashore, apply a bead of clear caulk to outline the outside of the fixtures mounting plate (1) where it meets the wall. Leave a small space at the bottom to allow any condensation or moisture to escape.
 5. Install bulb (8) (bulbs not included).
- (Don't exceed the maximum capacity recommended on the sockets).
