# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Disassemble drain and save ALL components.
- Place the vessel on top of the counter and make sure the drain fits down inside of the counter. If a mounting ring is used, place it under the sink. The mounting ring will elevate the sink ½" and provide stabilization.
- Use bead of silicone to seal between exterior of vessel where it is mounted to the mounting ring or counter.
- Use a level to ensure the vessel is level in every direction and install the drain.
- Align drain of the sink and tail pipe then partially thread drain body to tail pipe.
- **Connect tail pipe** to plumbing then firmly thread drain to tail pipe.
- Secure the vessel to the counter with fastener on the drain. Be sure to not over tighten the drain assembly. Hand tightening will be sufficient.

TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS		
<u>Issue</u>	<u>Reason</u>	<u>Solution</u>
Sink wobbles or is loose	Mounting ring not used; drain is loose	Use mounting ring adding a bit of silicone if still wobbly; tighten drain
Does not completely drain	Pop-up is too high; wrong seal used	Make sure correct seal is used and is below bevel
Leakage under sink	Drain has come loose; rubber washers not installed properly	Tighten brass fastener under the countertop; re-set washer properly
