




# Installation Instructions


**Block Collection** 

Following these mounting instructions with the hardware included will be more than sufficient to support vanity installation.











#### **1. Prepare Location**

Locate studs in the wall. If the studs do not line up with the holes in the back of the sink and vanity, be sure to add sufficient wall supports behind the finished wall.

## 2. Install Legs

Lay vanity cabinet on it's back. screw on the feet with phillips screwdriver.







#### 3. Mount Vanity Bracket


Mark the desired height of the vanity on the wall. Mark the location of the vanity. Drill pilot holes and install the mounting brackets. Check position with a level.


## 4. Install Vanity Base

Remove drawers. Slide vanity onto mounting brackets. Check for level. Secure with nuts.











# 6. Mount Sink With Washers and Nuts

Thread the sink on to the two hanger bolts. Secure the sink with insulation sleeves, washers and nuts. Be careful not to over tighten the bolts. Over tightening can cause the sink to chip and crack.

## 7. Install Caulk

Finish the sink installation with a bead of caulk between the sink and wall.





# 8. Install Handles

Screw on handles with phillips screwdriver. Replace drawers.

#### 9. Vanity Accessories

Complete your installation by adding the preferred plumbing accessories, such as the faucet, click clack drain, p-trap and angle valves to your vanity.
