
1. Prepare Location

Locate studs in the wall. If the studs do not line up with the vanity mounting brackets, be sure to add sufficient wall supports behind the finished wall.






2. Mount Vanity Bracket

Mark the desired height of the vanity on the wall. Mark the location of the vanity. Drill pilot holes and install the mounting brackets. Check position with a level.



3. Install Vanity Base

Remove drawers. Rest vanity on mounting brackets. Check for level. Use a phillips head screwdriver to adjust.





4. Drop in Sink

Install the sink with a bead of silicon and finish with a bead of caulk between the sink and wall.

5. Install Handles

Screw on handles with phillips screwdriver. Replace drawers.



6. Vanity Accessories

Complete your installation by adding the preferred plumbing accessories, such as the faucet, click clack drain, p-trap and angle valves to your vanity.
