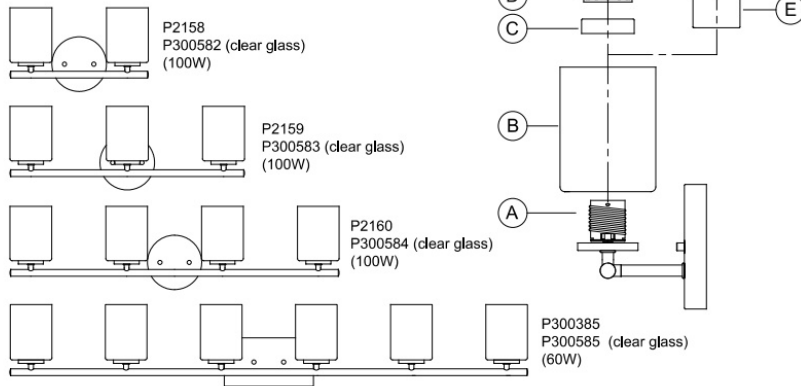

Disconnect Power at the main circuit breaker panel or main fusebox before starting and during the installation.

CAUTION: All glass is fragile. Use care when handling glass shades and bulbs.

WARNING:

1. This fixture is intended for installation in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) and all local code specifications. If you are not familiar with code requirements, installation by a qualified electrician is recommended. Failure to adhere to these codes and instructions may void the warranty.

- Always disconnect power and properly isolate it before cleaning.
- Only a soft damp cloth should be used. Harsh cleaning products may damage the finish.

Preparation

1. Before beginning installation, make sure all parts are included using the contents diagrams from page 1. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install or operate the product.
2. Estimated assembly time: 30 minutes.
3. Tools required for assembly (not included): Phillips screwdriver, pliers, wire stripper, safety glasses, electrical tape, ladder.

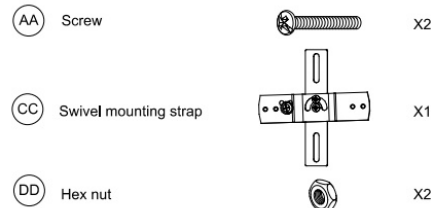
Care and Maintenance

Shut off main power supply before cleaning product or changing light bulbs. To clean, wipe with damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaners that contain alcohol.

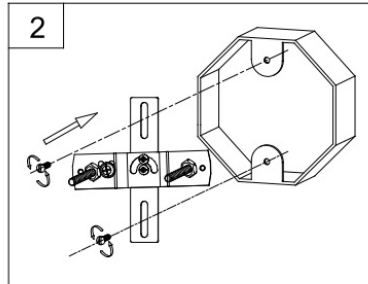
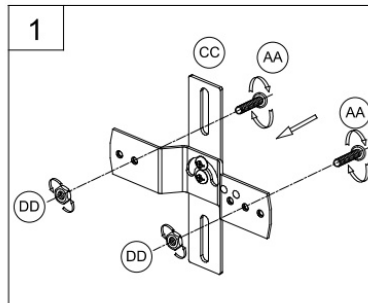
Assembly Instructions

1. Screw screws (AA) onto swivel mounting strap (CC) and use the hex nuts (DD) to secure it tight.

Hardware Used



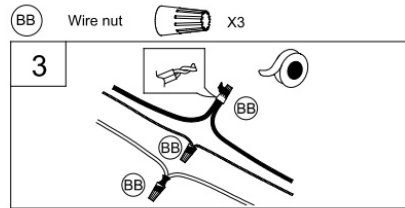
2. Attach assembled parts from step 1 onto junction box, using the mounting screws supplied with the junction box (not included).



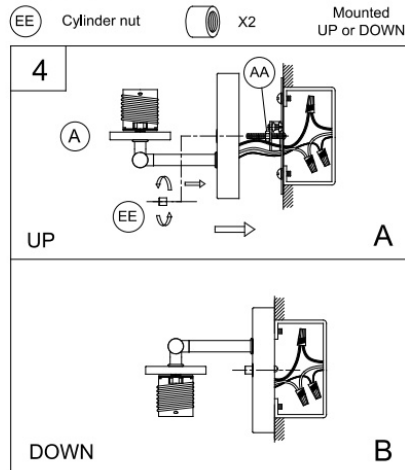
Assembly Instructions

3. Strip 3/8" of insulation from the electrical wire ends. Using wire nuts (BB), connect white fixture wire to the white supply wire from the junction box; connect the black fixture wire to the black supply wire.

Connect the fixture ground wire and supply ground wire using a wire nut or by fastening to the ground screw on the swivel mounting strap. Push all wire connections into the outlet box.

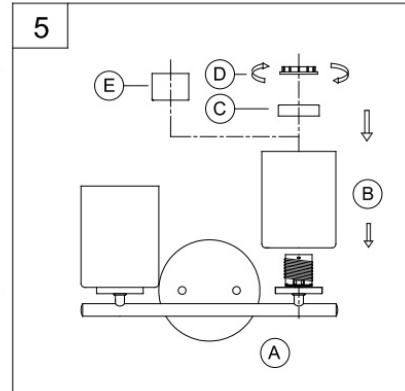


4. Attach fixture (A) to screws (AA) using cylinder nuts (EE). Secure tightly.

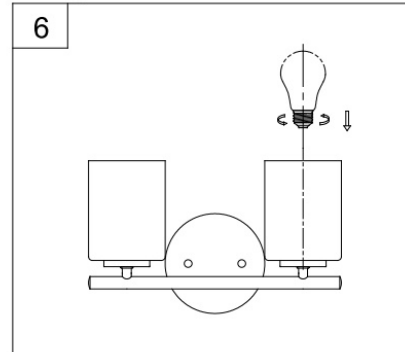


5. Attach glass (B) to fixture (A) and use socket ring (C) to secure tight.

NOTE: For P300582, P300583, P300584, P300585 clear glass shade, use socket ring (E) and tighten the glass shade (B) onto the fixture (A) socket.



6. Screw lamp (not included) into fixture socket. Use 60 or 100-watt MAX (see page 1) incandescent medium base lamp, SBCFL or SBLED.
