Tools required for assembly: Electrical tape, Phillips Screwdriver, Pliers, Safety Glasses, Step Ladder, Wire Cutters and Wire Strippers

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product. Failure to do so could lead to electrical shock, fire or other injuries that could be hazardous or even fatal.

- Before you begin installing the fixture, disconnect the power by removing fuses or turning off the circuit breakers.
- The net weight of the fixture is 5.94 lb (2,7 kg).
- FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

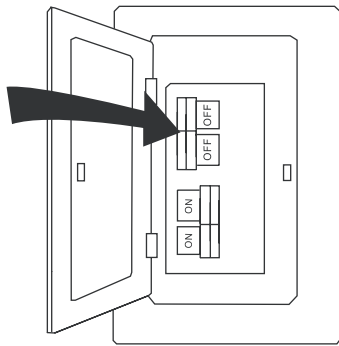
DANGER:

- DO NOT connect this fixture to an electrical system that does not provide a means for equipment grounding. Never use a fixture in a two-wire system that is not grounded. Installing a fixture into an electrical system not having a proper grounding means could cause metal parts of the fixture to carry electrical currents if any of the fixture wires, wire connections or splices were to become broken, cut or loose during the mounting or normal operation of the fixture. Under this condition, anyone coming in contact with the fixture would be subject to electrical shock, which could cause serious injury or death.
- DO NOT connect the bare or green insulation fixture ground wire to the black (hot) current-carrying wire or the white neutral house wire. Connection of the bare or green fixture ground wire to the black or white house wires may cause metal parts of the fixture to carry electrical currents. Under this condition anyone coming in contact with the fixture will receive electrical shock, which could cause serious injury or death.
- DO NOT damage or cut the wire insulation (covering) during installation of the fixture. DO NOT permit wires to contact any surface having a sharp edge. To do so may damage or cut the wire insulation, which could cause serious injury or death from electrical shock.

WARNING:

- All electrical connections must be in agreement with local codes and ordinances, the National Electric Code (NEC) and ANSI/NFPA 70-1999. Contact your municipal building department to learn about your local codes, permits and/or inspections. Risk of fire - most dwellings built before 1985 have supply wire rated for 140°F. Consult a qualified electrician before installation.
- To avoid personal injury, the use of gloves may be necessary while handling fixture parts with sharp edges.
- DO NOT suspend any fixture by the house wires. A fixture must always be mounted directly to a an outlet box. Wire connectors will not support the weight of a fixture. Suspending a fixture by the house wires and wire connectors will result in the fixture falling, with the possibility of personal injury and the danger of electrical shock or fire.
- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, each wire connector used with this light kit should accept only one 18-gauge wire from the light fixture and one 18-gauge wire from the outlet box. If there are three or more wires to connect or any of the wires is larger than 18 gauges, consult an electrician for the proper size wire connectors to use.

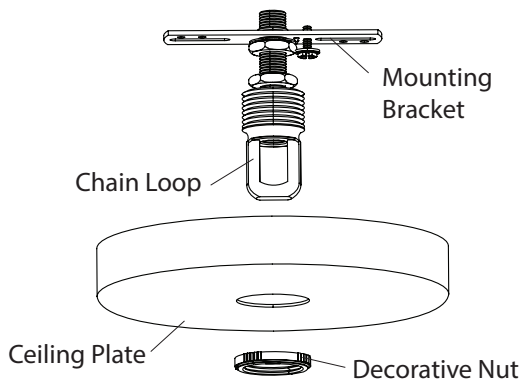

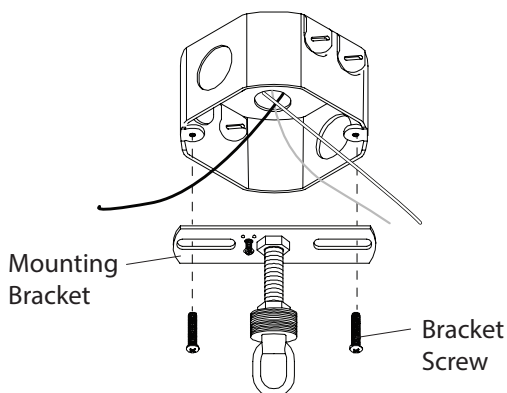
1. Turn OFF the electrical power at the main fuse or circuit breaker.

DANGER: Failure to disconnect the power supply prior to installation may result in serious injury or death.



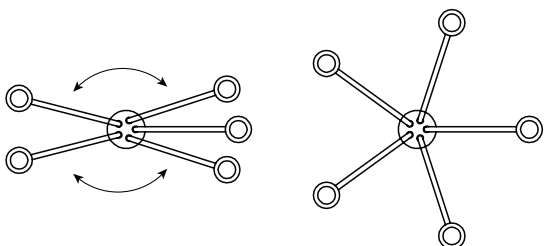

2. Remove the decorative nut from the chain loop. Remove the mounting bracket from the ceiling plate.

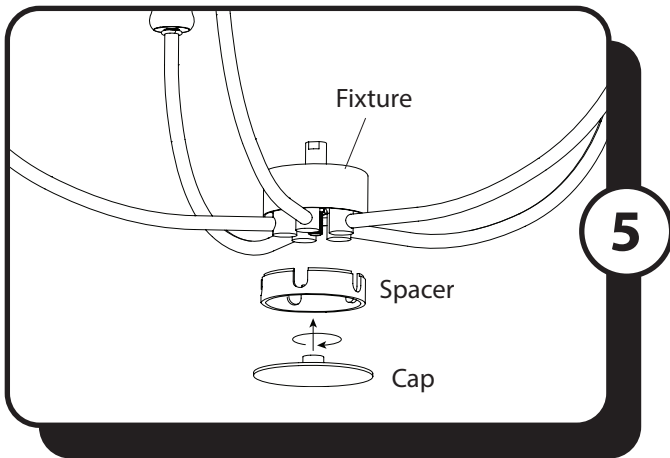
3. Use the bracket screws from the hardware bag to attach the mounting bracket securely to the outlet box.



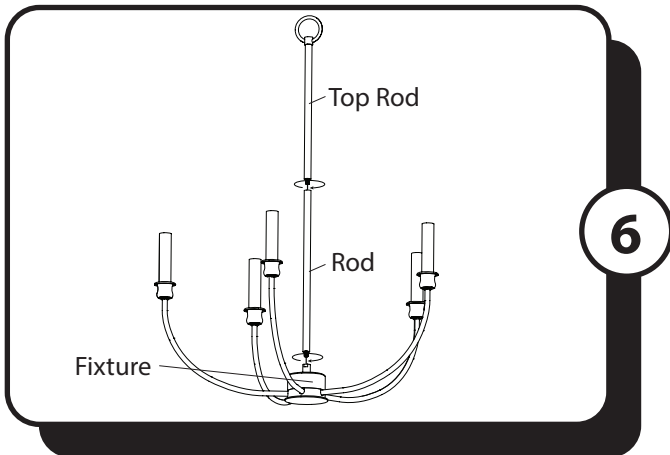

4. Swivel the arms of the fixture so there is equal distance between the arms.

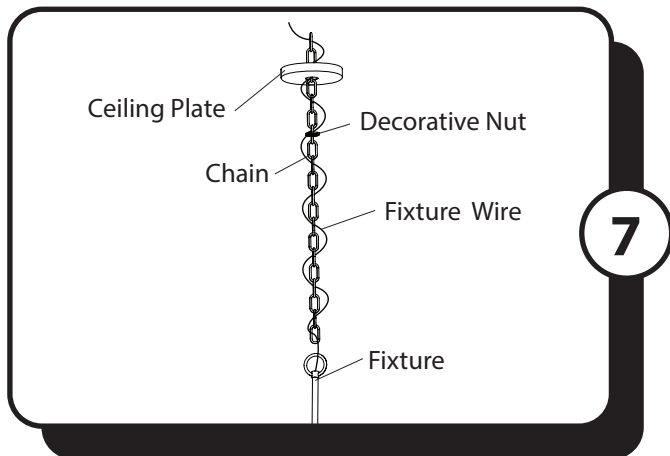

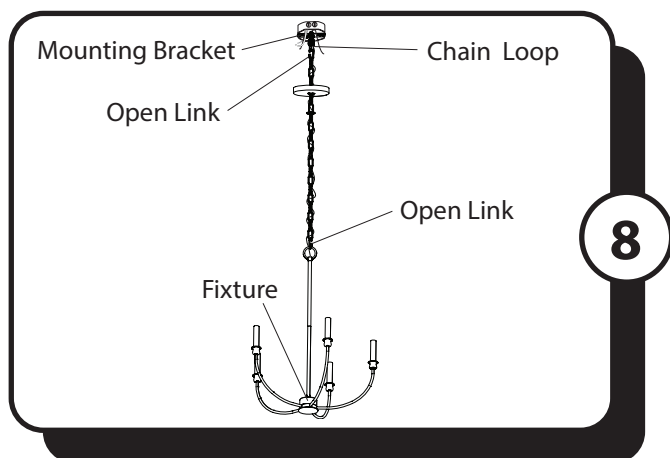
5. Lift the spacer to the bottom of fixture and attach the cap by twisting in a clockwise direction to secure.



6. Twist the wire ends coming from the fixture together and feed through hole in the first rod. Connect the first rod to the fixture by twisting the threaded end onto the fixture in a clockwise direction until secure. Install top rod with loops last as they will be used to hang the fixture on open links.

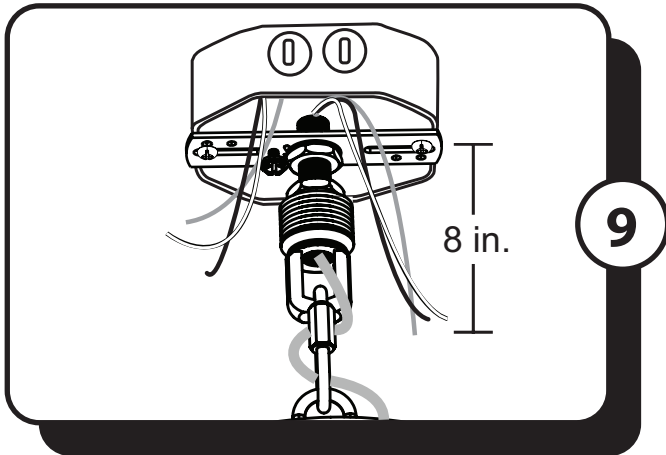


7. If desired, shorten the chain to desired length. Then, weave the fixture wires from the fixture through the loops of the chain, decorative nut, and ceiling plate.

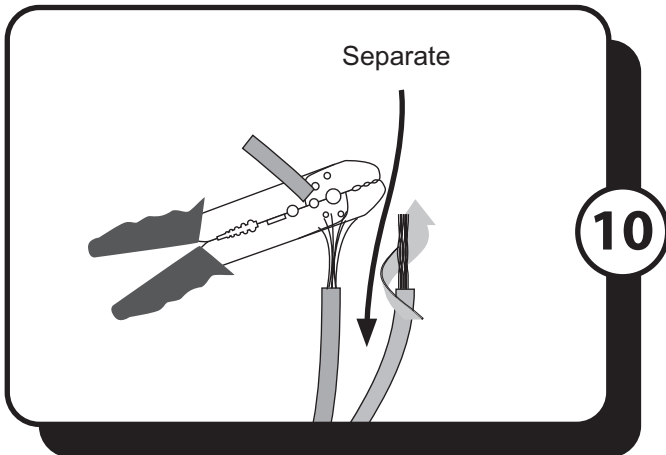


8. Use the two open links to attach the chain to the fixture and chain loop. Twist the wire ends together and feed the wires through the hole in the center of the chain loop and out through the hole in the mounting bracket.

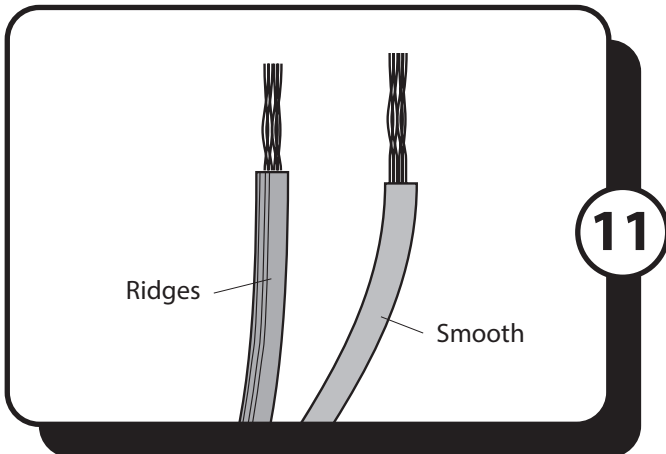

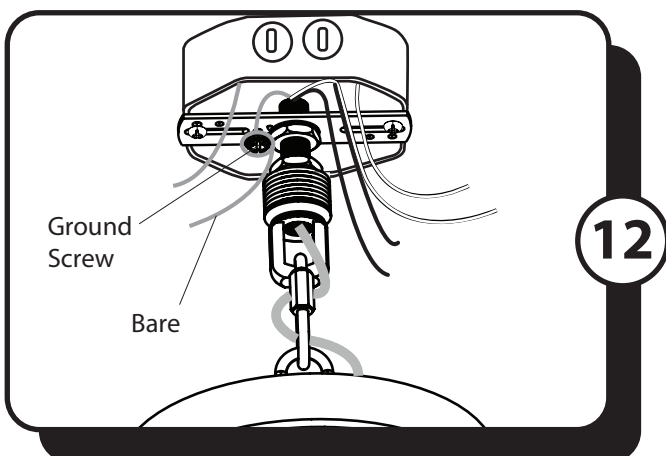
9. If you shortened the chain, you may need to cut the lead wires back to simplify wiring. If so, measure approximately 8 inches and use wire cutters (sold separately) to cut off the excess wire.



10. Separate the two wires all the way to the mounting bracket. Strip 1/2 in. of insulation from the end of the wires. Twist the stripped ends of each strand of wire within the insulation with pliers (not included).

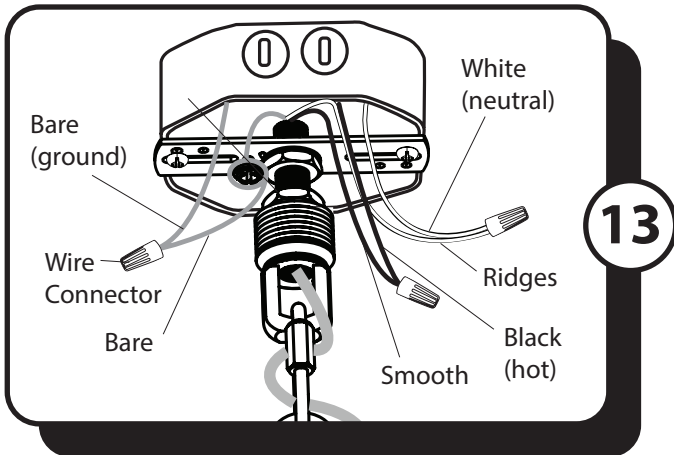


11. Notice one wire is smooth and the other has ridges on one side.



12. Loosen the ground screw on the mounting bracket and wrap the bare wire from the fixture around the ground screw. Tighten the ground screw to hold the bare wire in place. **Note:** Ensure there is enough of the bare wire extending from the ground screw to connect to the ground wire from the outlet box using a wire connector.

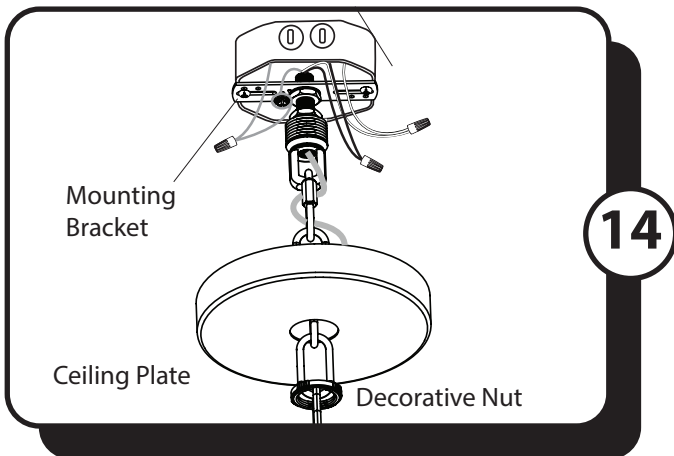

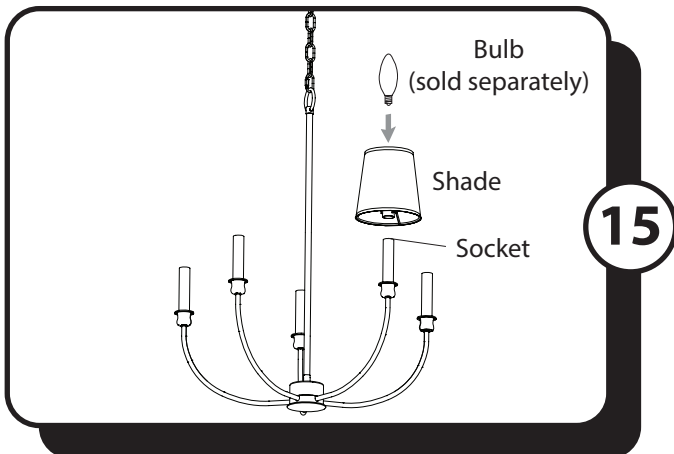
13. Use wire connectors to secure the household supply wires to the fixture wires according to the image and the following instructions:

- Connect the black (hot) supply wire to the smooth wire from the fixture.
- Connect the white (neutral) supply wire to the wire with ridges from the fixture.
- Connect the bare/green (ground) supply wire to the bare wire from the fixture.

Turn the wire connections and gently push them into the outlet box.

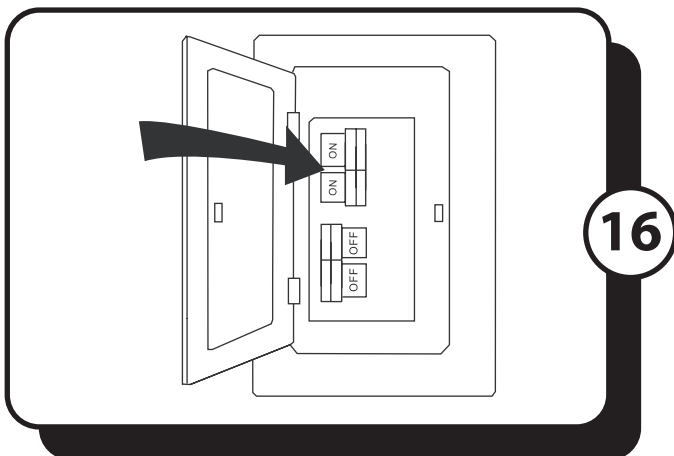


14. Lift the ceiling plate flush with the ceiling. Use the decorative nut to secure the ceiling plate.



15. Lift the shade onto the socket of the fixture. Install an E12-base bulb (sold separately) into the socket to secure the shade. Repeat for each shade.

Note: Fixture is compatible with any E12-base LED, CFL, or incandescent bulbs (60 watt max.).



16. Restore the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker and wall switch.

Assembly is complete.

TROUBLESHOOTING

WARNING: Ensure the power is turned off to the light fixture before performing any maintenance.

PROBLEM	SUGGESTED REMEDY
1. Fixture does not light up.	1. Ensure power is on at the wall switch and fuses or circuit breakers. 2. Check wire connections. 3. Replace the bulb.
2. Ceiling plate does not sit flush with ceiling.	Remove the chain loop from the threaded rod and adjust the hex nuts on the lower part of the threaded rod. Reinstall the chain loop.
