INSTALLATION

Diagram 1 shows a mounting template being held against a wall. A mounting bracket is positioned against the wall, and a pencil is used to mark the location of the mounting holes. A callout shows a close-up of a mounting hole.

Hold the mounting template at the desired location. Hold each mounting bracket against the wall, and mark the location of the mounting holes on each bracket.

Diagram 2 shows a pilot hole being drilled into the wall. An anchor is inserted into the hole, and a screw is used to secure the mounting bracket to the wall.

Drill a pilot hole at each marked mounting hole location. **If drilling through tile, you must use a masonry drill bit to avoid cracking the tile.** Insert the anchors into the drilled holes, and secure each mounting bracket to the wall using the provided screws.

Diagram 3 shows the left and right bases being attached to the mounting brackets. A set screw is used to secure the bases, and a hex wrench is used to tighten it.

Attach each base to the installed mounting brackets. Tighten the set screw located on the bottom of each base to fasten. Ensure that the holes for the roll rod are facing inward, as shown.

Diagram 4 shows the roll rod being inserted into the holes of the bases. The rod is pushed inward, and the opposite side is set in place.

To complete the installation, install the roll rod, as shown. Slide one side of the rod into its hole, press inward, then set the opposite side of the rod in place.
