► The new Optima® faucet — Bringing intelligence to water

Sloan's new Optima i.q. EAF-750 Series electronic hand washing faucets operate by means of a dual infrared sensor and microprocessor based logic. The modular design incorporates all of the operating components of the faucet, including the sensor, solenoid, circuitry and battery above the sink within a die-cast metal spout.

Optima i.q. EAF-750 series faucets include a 6 VDC lithium battery. Battery life is approximately three (3) years.

Battery shelf life is ten years. Battery service life varies with usage.

ISM models feature an integral temperature control lever which allows the user to adjust the water temperature. This adjustment can also be converted to a fixed setting. EAF faucets ordered without the ISM variation must be connected to a single, pretempered water supply.

The i.q.-Click feature allows the user to place the faucet into optional function modes, including "continuous run" and "temporary off" simply by pressing a button on the spout. The use of the i.q.-Click feature is recommended only in installations where users have a regular familiarity with the faucet (i.e., executive and non-public rest rooms). Models furnished with the i.q.-Click feature are also available with a Drain Pop Up.


Optima i.q.® Gooseneck Faucet EAF-750-ISM

▶ OPERATION

As the user's hands enter the beam's effective range, the beam is reflected back into the sensor receiver and activates the solenoid valve allowing water to flow from the faucet. Water will flow until the hands are removed or until the faucet reaches its automatic time out limit setting.



Trim Plate for 4" (102 mm) Centerset Sink

SFP-22

Trim Plate for 8" (204 mm) Centerset Sink
