## **Safety Alert Definitions**

Throughout this guide are safety items labeled with a Danger, Warning or Caution based on the risk type:



Danger means that failure to follow this safety statement will result in severe personal injury or death.

#### Items Included in Kit

- 10' Braided Water Line
- Ice Maker Adapter Kit
- Hose Washer (may be part of Adapter kit)



## **NOTICE**

Not all items shipped in kit will be used. Please dispose of the pictured items. Also remove and dispose of brass compression nut and ferule from elbow.



### **Installation Procedure**

 Apply Teflon tape (not included) onto the threaded elbow brass fitting. Only apply Teflon tape to the smaller fitting on the brass elbow (as shown). The larger fitting on the elbow does not need tape.



- 2. Insert the elbow into the garden hose connector provided and tighten.
- 3. Insert washer into garden hose connector.
- 4. Tighten onto water valve.
- 5. Install braided connection onto the larger thread of the brass elbow.





DO NOT over tighten connections as damage to washer might occur.

- 6. Route braided line to water shut-off and connect.
- 7. Turn on water and check for leaks.
