
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER AT THE MAIN FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements. 2. READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.


- 6. Secure the top loop to the nipple.
- 7. Choose the length of the chain you need, then weave the fixture wire and the fixture grounding wire through the chain, collar, decorative leaf and canopy.
- 8. Connect one end of the chain with the loop by using a loop lock.
- 9. Connect the other end of the chain with the top loop by using another loop lock.
- 10. Thread the fixture wire and fixture grounding wire through the top loop, nipple and mounting strap.
- 11. Pull out the outlet wires and house grounding wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire nuts:
 - ---The smooth wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ---The ridged wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting strap with the green grounding screw. Then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.
 - Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.
- 12. Attach the canopy and decorative leaves to the mounting strap by inserting the top loop, then secure it with the collar.

Note: The decorative leaves must be staggered.

- 13. Attach the candle tube into the socket on the main fixture body.
- 14. Install bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 15. Screw the nipple-1 into the coupling on main fixture. Secure it with hex nut. Slide the cap and decorative leaves-1 onto the nipple-1, thread the finial onto the nipple-1.

Note: The decorative leaves must be staggered.

16. Turn on the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker box.
