
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: Turn off the main power at circuit breaker before installing fixture. AVERTISSEMENT: Coupez la source d'alimentation principale au panneau central de disjoncteurs avant d'installer le luminaire.

- NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements.

Installation Steps


Turn off the power at fuse or circuit box


- 1. Take a side glass panel (H) and gently place the side glass panel into the metal frame in place, then pressing the clips of the metal frame to secure the side glass panel. (See Fig.1)
- 2. Repeat this process to complete all glass panel installation of side glass panels (H) and front glass panel (F).
- 3. Take an upper glass panel (G) and gently place the upper glass panel into the dome in place, then pressing the clips of the dome to secure the upper glass panel (G). (See Fig. 2) Repeat with other upper glass panels (G).
- 4. Attach the dome to the metal frames, then secure it with the bolt nut assemblies.
- 5. Attach the crossbar unit (A) to the outlet box by using two mounting screws (B) Adjust the length of the preinstalled headless screws if necessary.

Note: Make sure that the headless screws are lined up horizontally to make the fixture level.

- 6. Pull out the outlet wires and the house ground wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections by using the wire connectors (C):
 - --- Connect the black (hot) wire from the fixture to the black (hot) wire from the power source.
 - --- Connect the white (neutral) wire from the fixture to the white (neutral) wire from the power source.
 - --- Attach the fixture ground wire to the crossbar unit (A) with the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with a wire connector (C).

Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.







- 7. Attach the backplate of the fixture to the crossbar unit (A) by inserting fixture mounting screws into set holes on the backplate, then secure it with two rubber pads (E) and two bolt nuts (D).
 Note: With silicone caulk compound, caulk completely around where the backplate meets with the wall surface to prevent water from seeping into the outlet box.
- 8. Open the door of the fixture by pushing up the latch, attach the candle tube (I) onto the socket.
- 9. Install the bulbs (not included). Check relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.
- 10. Close the door of the fixture by pulling down the latch.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box.
