



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Install the Fixture



- I Secure the mounting plate to the junction box.
- Place the shade on to the socket and secure it in place by screwing the shade collar nut onto the socket. Do not over tighten. If necessary, repeat for all the other shades.
- 3 Screw the lamp(s) into the socket(s). Refer to the label on the socket for Max Wattage Information.
- 4 Connect the fixture to a suitable ground in accordance with local electrical codes.
- 5 Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 6 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.
- Neatly place the wires into the junction box, place the fixture onto the mounting studs, and secure it in place by screwing the cap nuts onto the studs.
